- Yehowah is near to those that are broken at heart, and those who are crushed in spirit he saves. (Psalms 34:18)
- Many are the calamities of the righteous one, but out of them all Yehowah delivers him. (Psalms 34:19)
- Raise YOUR eyes high up and see. Who has created these things? It is the One who is bringing forth the army of them even by number, all of whom he calls even by name. Due to the abundance of dynamic energy, he also being vigorous in power, not one of them is missing. (Isaiah 40:26)
- My hand made all these things, did it not? (Acts of Apostles 7:50)
- For the reason that your heart was soft so that you humbled yourself because of Yehowah at your hearing what I have spoken against this place and its inhabitants for it to become an object of astonishment and a malediction, and then you ripped your garments apart and began weeping before me, I, even I, have heard, is the utterance of Yehowah. (2 Kings 22:19)
