Psalms 122:1" I rejoiced when they were saying to me; To the house of Yehowah let us go.

- These things I will remember, and I will pour out my soul within me. For I used to pass along with the throng, I used to walk slowly before them to the house of God, with the voice of a joyful cry and thanksgiving, of a crowd celebrating a festival. (Psalms 42:4)
- Because we used to enjoy sweet intimacy together, into the house of God we used to walk with the throng. (Psalms 55:14)
- That I may see the goodness to your chosen ones, that I may rejoice with the rejoicing of your nation, that I may make my boast with your inheritance. (Psalms 106:5)
- One thing I have asked from Yehowah, it is what I shall look for; That I may dwell in the house of Yehowah all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah and to look with appreciation upon his temple. (Psalms 27:4)
- And David and all the house of Israel were bringing up the ark of Yehowah with joyful shouting and sound of horn. (2 Samuel 6:15)
