Isaiah 44:23... Joyfully cry out, you heavens, for Yehowah has taken action! Shout in triumph, all you lowest parts of the earth! Become cheerful, you mountains, with joyful outcry, you forest and all you trees in it! For Yehowah has repurchased Jacob, and on Israel he shows his beauty.

- Be glad over her, O heaven, also you holy ones and you apostles and you prophets, because God has judicially exacted punishment for you from her! (Revelation 18:20)
- · Also, there will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth anguish of nations, not knowing the way out because of the roaring of the sea and its agitation. (Luke 21:25)
- While men become faint out of fear and expectation of the things coming upon the inhabited earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (Luke 21:26)
- And he went on to say to me; Son of man, as regards these bones, they are the whole house of Israel. Here they are saying; Our bones have become dry, and our hope has perished. We have been severed off to ourselves. (Ezekiel 37:11)
- Therefore prophesy, and you must say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am opening Your burial places, and I will bring You up out of Your burial places, O my people, and bring You in upon the soil of Israel. (Ezekiel 37:12)
- And you will have to know that I am Yehowah when I open your burial places and when I bring you up out of your burial places, O my people. (Ezekiel 37:13)

Yehowah, have spoken and I have done it, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Ezekiel 37:14)

- Listen to me, O you islands, and pay attention, you national groups far away. Yehowah himself has called me even from the belly. From the inward parts of my mother he has made mention of my name. (Isaiah 49:1)
- And he proceeded to make my mouth like a sharp sword. In the shadow of his hand he has hidden me. And he gradually made me a polished arrow. He concealed me in his own quiver. (Isaiah 49:2)
- And he went on to say to me; You are my servant, O Israel, you the one in whom I shall show my beauty. (Isaiah 49:3)
- Let heaven and earth praise him, the seas and everything moving about in them. (Psalms 69:34)
- Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be joyful. Let the sea thunder and that which fills it. (Psalms 96:11)
- Shout in triumph to Yehowah, all you people of the earth. Be cheerful and cry out joyfully and make melody. (Psalms 98:4)
- Shout in triumph to Yehowah, all you people of the earth. (Psalms 100:1)
- You, whom I have taken hold of from the extremities of the earth, and you, whom I have called even from the remote parts of it. And so I said to you; You are my servant, I have chosen you, and I have not rejected you. (Isaiah 41:9)
- Sing to Yehowah a new song, his praise from the extremity of the earth, you men that are going down to the sea and to that which fills it, you islands and you inhabiting them. (Isaiah 42:10)
- Also, all the time I am the same One, and there is no one effecting deliverance out of my own hand. I shall get active, and who can turn it back? (Isaiah 43:13)
- Give a glad cry, you heavens, and be joyful, you earth. Let the mountains become cheerful with a glad outcry. For Yehowah has comforted his people, and he shows pity upon his own afflicted ones. (Isaiah 49:13)
- For with rejoicing You people will go forth, and with peace You will be brought in. The mountains and the hills themselves will become

cheerful before you with a joyful outcry, and the very trees of the field will all clap their hands. (Isaiah 55:12)

- And as for your people, all of them will be righteous, to time indefinite they will hold possession of the land, the sprout of my planting, the work of my hands, for me to be beautified. (Isaiah 60:21)
- Let the rivers themselves clap their hands, all together let the very mountains cry out joyfully (Psalms 98:8)
- You mountains and all you hills, you fruit trees and all you cedars. (Psalms 148:9)
- I have brought near my righteousness. It is not far away, and my own salvation will not be late. And I will give in Zion salvation, to Israel my beauty. (Isaiah 46:13)
- Become cheerful, cry out joyfully in unison, you devastated places of Jerusalem, for Yehowah has comforted his people, he has repurchased Jerusalem. (Isaiah 52:9)
- Cry out joyfully, you barren woman that did not give birth!

 Become cheerful with a joyful outcry and cry shrilly, you that had no childbirth pains, for the sons of the desolated one are more numerous than the sons of the woman with a husbandly owner, Yehowah has said. (Isaiah 54:1)
- As for me, shall I cause the breaking through and not cause the giving birth, says Yehowah? Or am I causing a giving birth and do I actually cause a shutting up? your God has said. (Isaiah 66:9)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; CRY out loudly to Jacob with rejoicing, and CRY shrilly at the head of nations. Publish it. Give praise and SAY, Save, O Yehowah, your people, the remnant of Israel. (Jeremiah 31:7)
- For Yehowah will actually redeem Jacob and reclaim him out of the hand of the one stronger than he is. (Jeremiah 31:11)
- And over Babylon the heavens and the earth and all that is in them will certainly cry out joyfully, for out of the north there will come to her the despoilers, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 51:48)
- And I will give them one heart, and a new spirit I shall put inside them, and I shall certainly remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh. (Ezekiel 11:19)

- Therefore, O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah! This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the mountains and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys and to the devastated places that were laid desolate and to the abandoned cities that have come to be for plunder and for ridicule to the remaining ones of the nations that are round about. (Ezekiel 36:4)
- And you yourselves, O mountains of Israel, will give forth your very own boughs and bear your own fruitage for my people Israel, for they have drawn near to the point of coming in. (Ezekiel 36:8)
- Not for Your sakes am I doing this, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, let it be known to You. Be ashamed and feel humiliation because of Your ways, O house of Israel. (Ezekiel 36:32)
- Be very joyful, O daughter of Zion. Shout in triumph, O daughter of Jerusalem. Look! Your king himself comes to you. He is righteous, yes, saved, humble, and riding upon an ass, even upon a full-grown animal the son of a she-ass. (Zechariah 9:9)
