Raise your eyes all around and see! They have all of them been collected together, they have come to you. From far away your own sons keep coming, and your daughters who will be taken care of on the flank.

- Consequently I reckon that the sufferings of the present season do not amount to anything in comparison with the glory that is going to be revealed in us. (Romans 8:18)
- For the eager expectation of the creation is waiting for the revealing of the sons of God. (Romans 8:19)
- For the creation was subjected to futility, not by its own will but through him that subjected it, on the basis of hope (Romans 8:20)
- That the creation itself also will be set free from enslavement to corruption and have the glorious freedom of the children of God. (Romans 8:21)
- For we know that all creation keeps on groaning together and being in pain together until now. (Romans 8:22)
- Before she began to come into labor pains she gave birth. Before birth pangs could come to her, she even gave deliverance to a male child. (Isaiah 66:7)
- Who has heard of a thing like this? Who has seen things like these? Will a land be brought forth with labor pains in one day? Or will a nation be born at one time? For Zion has come into labor pains as well as given birth to her sons. (Isaiah 66:8)
- As for me, shall I cause the breaking through and not cause the giving birth, says Yehowah? Or am I causing a giving birth and do I actually cause a shutting up? your God has said. (Isaiah 66:9)

- And a great sign was seen in heaven, a woman arrayed with the sun, and the moon was beneath her feet, and on her head was a crown of twelve stars. (Revelation 12:1)
- And she was pregnant. And she cries out in her pains and in her agony to give birth. (Revelation 12:2)
- And another sign was seen in heaven, and, look! A great fiery-colored dragon, with seven heads and ten horns and upon its heads seven diadems. (Revelation 12:3)
- And its tail drags a third of the stars of heaven, and it hurled them down to the earth. And the dragon kept standing before the woman who was about to give birth, that, when she did give birth, it might devour her child. (Revelation 12:4)

- And I will rock all the nations, and the desirable things of all the nations must come in, and I will fill this house with glory, Yehowah of armies has said. (Haggai 2:7)
- And I have other sheep, which are not of this fold, those also I must bring, and they will listen to my voice, and they will become one flock, one shepherd. (John 10:16)

- And in response one of the elders said to me; These who are dressed in the white robes, who are they and where did they come from? (Revelation 7:13)
- The daughters of kings are among your precious women. The queenly consort has taken her stand at your right hand in gold of Ophir. (Psalms 45:9)
- In that time a gift will be brought to Yehowah of armies, from a people drawn out and scoured, even from a people fear-inspiring everywhere, a nation of tensile strength and of treading down, whose land the rivers have washed away, to the place of the name of Yehowah of armies, Mount Zion. - For in me the islands themselves will keep hoping, the ships of Tarshish also as at the first, in order to bring your sons from far away, their silver and their gold being with them, to the name of Yehowah your God and to the Holy One of Israel, for he will have beautified you. (Isaiah 60:9)
- And their offspring will actually be known even among the nations, and their descendants in among the peoples. All those seeing them will recognize them, that they are the offspring whom Yehowah has blessed. (Isaiah 61:9)
- And they will actually bring all YOUR brothers out of all the nations as a gift to Yehowah, on horses and in chariots and in covered wagons and on mules and on swift she-camels, up to my holy mountain,

Jerusalem, Yehowah has said, just as when the sons of Israel bring the gift in a clean vessel into the house of Yehowah. (Isaiah 66:20)
