Psalms 79:4" We have become a reproach to our neighbors, a derision and a jeering to those round about us.

- And you must become an object of astonishment, a proverbial saying and a taunt among all the peoples to whom Yehowah will lead you away. (Deuteronomy 28:37)
- Therefore, O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah! This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the mountains and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys and to the devastated places that were laid desolate and to the abandoned cities that have come to be for plunder and for ridicule to the remaining ones of the nations that are round about. (Ezekiel 36:4)
- You set us as a reproach to our neighbors, a derision and jeering to those all around us. (Psalms 44:13)
- You set us for strife to our neighbors, and our very enemies keep deriding as they please. (Psalms 80:6)
- Accordingly they said to me; Those left over, who have been left over from the captivity, there in the jurisdictional district, are in a very bad plight and in reproach, and the wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its very gates have been burned with fire. (Nehemiah 1:3)
- Now when Sanballat the Horonite and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, and Geshem the Arabian heard of it, they began to deride us and look on us despisingly and say; What is this thing that you are doing? Is it against the king that you are rebelling? (Nehemiah 2:19)
- How long, O God, will the adversary keep reproaching? Will the enemy keep treating your name with disrespect forever? (Psalms 74:10)

- All day long my enemies have reproached me. Those making a fool of me have sworn even by me. (Psalms 102:8)
- So I shall profane the princes of the holy place, and I will give Jacob over as a man devoted to destruction and Israel over to words of abuse. (Isaiah 43:28)
- This is what Yehowah has said against all my bad neighbors, who are touching the hereditary possession that I caused my people, even Israel, to possess; Here I am uprooting them from off their ground, and the house of Judah I shall uproot from the midst of them. (Jeremiah 12:14)
- We have been put to shame, for we have heard reproach. Humiliation has covered our faces, for strangers have come against the holy places of the house of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 51:51)
- Remember, O Yehowah, what has happened to us. Do look and see our reproach. (Lamentations 5:1)
- And you must become a reproach and an object of reviling words, a warning example and a horror to the nations that are all around you, when I do in you acts of judgment in anger and in rage and in raging reproofs. I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. (Ezekiel 5:15)
- By your blood that you have shed you have become guilty, and by your dungy idols that you have made you have become unclean. And you bring your days near, and you will come to your years. That is why I must make you an object of reproach to the nations and of jeering to all the lands. (Ezekiel 22:4)
- The lands nearby and those far away from you will jeer you, O you unclean in name, abounding in confusion. (Ezekiel 22:5)
- O Yehowah, according to all your acts of righteousness, please, may your anger and your rage turn back from your city Jerusalem, your holy mountain, for, because of our sins and because of the errors of our forefathers, Jerusalem and your people are an object of reproach to all those round about us. (Daniel 9:16)
