- Therefore here I am, the One that will act wonderfully again with this people, in a wonderful manner and with something wonderful, and the wisdom of their wise men must perish, and the very understanding of their discreet men will conceal itself. (Isaiah 29:14)
- And you must keep and do them, because this is wisdom on YOUR part and understanding on YOUR part before the eyes of the peoples who will hear of all these regulations, and they will certainly say; This great nation is undoubtedly a wise and understanding people. (Deuteronomy 4:6)
- The Law of Yehowah is perfect, bringing back the soul. The reminder of Yehowah is trustworthy, making the inexperienced one wise. (Psalms 19:7)
