The one slaughtering the bull is as one striking down a man. The one sacrificing the sheep is as one breaking the neck of a dog. The one offering up a gift, the blood of a pig! The one presenting a memorial of frankincense is as one saying a blessing with uncanny words. They are also the ones that have chosen their own ways, and in their disgusting things their very soul has taken a delight.

- For rebelliousness is the same as the sin of divination, and pushing ahead presumptuously the same as using uncanny power and teraphim. Since you have rejected the word of Yehowah, he accordingly rejects you from being king. (1 Samuel 15:23)
- Of what benefit to me is the multitude of YOUR sacrifices, says Yehowah? I have had enough of whole burnt offerings of rams and the fat of well-fed animals, and in the blood of young bulls and male lambs and he-goats I have taken no delight. (Isaiah 1:11)
- When you people keep coming in to see my face, who is it that has required this from your hand, to trample my courtyards? (Isaiah 1:12)
- Stop bringing in any more valueless grain offerings. Incense, it is something detestable to me. New moon and Sabbath, the calling of a convention, I cannot put up with the use of uncanny power along with the solemn assembly. (Isaiah 1:13)
- Your new moons and your festal seasons my soul has hated. To me they have become a burden, I have become tired of bearing them. (Isaiah 1:14)
- And when you spread out your palms, I hide my eyes from you. Even though you make many prayers, I am not listening, with bloodshed your very hands have become filled. (Isaiah 1:15)

- The pig also, because it is a splitter of the hoof but there is no cud. It is unclean for you. None of their flesh must you eat, and their carcasses you must not touch. (Deuteronomy 14:8)
- Seating themselves among the burial places, who also pass the night even in the watch huts, eating the flesh of the pig, even the broth of foul things being in their vessels. (Isaiah 65:4)
- Those sanctifying themselves and cleansing themselves for the gardens behind one in the center, eating the flesh of the pig and the loathsome thing, even the jumping rodent, they will all together reach their end, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Isaiah 66:17)
- And so I let them go in the stubbornness of their heart, they went walking in their own counsels. (Psalms 81:12)
- This is what Yehowah has said concerning this people; Thus they have loved to wander about, their feet they have not kept in check. So Yehowah himself has taken no pleasure in them. Now he will remember their error and will give attention to their sins. (Jeremiah 14:10)
- The sacrifice of the wicked ones is something detestable to Yehowah, but the prayer of the upright ones is a pleasure to him. (Proverbs 15:8)
- Do you not know that you people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple you people are. (1 Corinthians 3:17)
- For if we practice sin willfully after having received the accurate knowledge of the truth, there is no longer any sacrifice for sins left. (Hebrews 10:26)
- But there is a certain fearful expectation of judgment and there is a fiery jealousy that is going to consume those in opposition. (Hebrews 10:27)
- Any man that has disregarded the Law of Moses dies without compassion, upon the testimony of two or three. (Hebrews 10:28)
- Of how much more severe a punishment, do you think, will the man be counted worthy who has trampled upon the Son of God and who has esteemed as of ordinary value the blood of the covenant by

which he was sanctified, and who has outraged the spirit of undeserved kindness with contempt? (Hebrews 10:29)

- For we know him that said: Vengeance is mine, I will recompense. And again: Yehowah will judge his people. (Hebrews 10:30)
- It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. (Hebrews 10:31)
- · All the works they do they do to be viewed by men, for they broaden the scripture-containing cases that they wear as safeguards, and enlarge the fringes of their garments. (Matthew 23:5)
- They like the most prominent place at evening meals and the front seats in the synagogues. (Matthew 23:6)
- And the greetings in the marketplaces and to be called Rabbi by men. (Matthew 23:7)
- But you, do not you be called Rabbi, for one is your teacher, whereas all you are brothers. (Matthew 23:8)
- Moreover, do not call anyone your father on earth, for one is your Father, the heavenly One. (Matthew 23:9)
- Neither be called leaders, for YOUR Leader is one, the Christ. (Matthew 23:10)
- But the greatest one among you must be your minister. (Matthew 23:11)
- But Jesus, calling them to him, said; You know that the rulers of the nations lord it over them and the great men wield authority over them. (Matthew 20:25)
- This is not the way among you, but whoever wants to become great among you must be your minister. (Matthew 20:26)
- And whoever wants to be first among you must be your slave. (Matthew 20:27)
- Just as the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to give his soul a ransom in exchange for many. (Matthew 20:28)
- But whoever stumbles one of these little ones who put faith in me, it is more beneficial for him to have hung around his neck a

millstone such as is turned by an ass and to be sunk in the wide, open sea. (Matthew 18:6)

- Also the pig, because it is a splitter of the hoof and a former of a cleft in the hoof, but it itself does not chew the cud. It is unclean for YOU. (Leviticus 11:7)
- You have not brought me the sheep of your whole burnt offerings, and with your sacrifices you have not glorified me. I have not compelled you to serve me with a gift, nor have I made you weary with frankincense. (Isaiah 43:23)
- I myself shall tell forth your righteousness and your works, that they will not benefit you. (Isaiah 57:12)
- What does this matter to me that you bring in even frankincense from Sheba and the good cane from the land far away? The whole burnt offerings of you people serve for no pleasure, and your very sacrifices have not been gratifying to me. (Jeremiah 6:20)
- Like grapes in the wilderness I found Israel. Like the early fig on a fig tree in its beginning I saw the forefathers of you people. They themselves went in to Baal of Peor, and they proceeded to dedicate themselves to the shameful thing, and they came to be disgusting like the thing of their love. (Hosea 9:10)
- But if you people offer up to me whole burnt offerings, even in YOUR gift offerings I shall find no pleasure, and on YOUR communion sacrifices of fatlings I shall not look. (Amos 5:22)
- Accordingly Haggai answered and said; That is how this people is, and that is how this nation is before me, is the utterance of Yehowah, and that is how all the work of their hands is, and whatever they present there. It is unclean. (Haggai 2:14)
- And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and was adorned with gold and precious stone and pearls and had in her hand a golden cup that was full of disgusting things and the unclean things of her fornication. (Revelation 17:4)
