Psalms 27:1" Yehowah is my light and my salvation. Of whom shall I be in fear? Yehowah is the stronghold of my life. Of whom shall I be in dread?

- When he caused his lamp to shine upon my head, when I would walk through darkness by his light. (Job 29:3)
- For with you is the source of life, by light from you we can see light. (Psalms 36:9)
- Send out your light and your truth. May these themselves lead me. May they bring me to your holy mountain and to your grand tabernacle. (Psalms 43:3)
- Your word is a lamp to my foot, and a light to my roadway. (Psalms 119:105)
- My strength and my might is Yah, since he serves for my salvation. This is my God, and I shall laud him, my father's God, and I shall raise him on high. (Exodus 15:2)
- Blessed be Yehowah, who daily carries the load for us, the true God of our salvation. (Psalms 68:19)
- Even though I walk in the valley of deep shadow, I fear nothing bad, for you are with me, your rod and your staff are the things that comfort me. (Psalms 23:4)
- Indeed he is my rock and my salvation, my secure height, I shall not be made to totter. (Psalms 62:6)
- Look! God is my salvation. I shall trust and be in no dread, for Yah, Yehowah is my strength and my might, and he came to be the salvation of me. (Isaiah 12:2)

- · After these things the word of Yehowah came to Abram in a vision, saying; Do not fear, Abram. I am a shield for you. Your reward will be very great. (Genesis 15:1)
- And Yehowah proceeded to appear to him during that night and to say; I am the God of Abraham your father. Do not be afraid, because I am with you, and I will bless you and multiply your seed on account of Abraham my servant. (Genesis 26:24)
- Then Moses said to the people; Do not be afraid. Stand firm and see the salvation of Yehowah, which he will perform for you today. For the Egyptians whom you do see today you will not see again, no, never again. (Exodus 14:13)
- See, Yehowah your God has abandoned the land to you. Go up, take possession, just as Yehowah the God of your forefathers has spoken to you. Do not be afraid, nor be terrified. (Deuteronomy 1:21)
- You must not be afraid of them. You should by all means remember what Yehowah your God did to Pharaoh and all Egypt. (Deuteronomy 7:18)
- Happy you are, O Israel! Who is there like you, a people enjoying salvation in Yehowah, the shield of your help, and the One who is your eminent sword? So your enemies will cringe before you, and you, upon their high places you will tread. (Deuteronomy 33:29)
- Then Yehowah said to Joshua; Do not be afraid or be terrified. Take with you all the people of war and get up, go up to Ai. See, I have given into your hand the king of Ai and his people and his city and his land. (Joshua 8:1)
- At this Yehowah said to Joshua; Do not be afraid because of them, for tomorrow about this time I am abandoning all of them slain to Israel. Their horses you will hamstring, and their chariots you will burn in the fire. (Joshua 11:6)

- But the mountainous region should become yours. Because it is a forest, you must cut it down, and it must become the termination point for you. For you should drive away the Canaanites, although they have war chariots with iron scythes and they are strong. (Joshua 17:18)
- When Saul and all Israel heard these words of the Philistine, then they became terrified and were greatly afraid. (1 Samuel 17:11)

- For you are my lamp, O Yehowah, and it is Yehowah that makes my darkness shine. (2 Samuel 22:29)

- At that the angel of Yehowah spoke to Elijah; Go down with him. Do not be afraid because of him. So he rose and went down with him to the king. (2 Kings 1:15)
- When I saw their fear I immediately rose and said to the nobles and the deputy rulers and the rest of the people; Do not be afraid on their account. Yehowah the great and the fear-inspiring One keep in YOUR mind, and fight for YOUR brothers, YOUR sons and YOUR daughters, YOUR wives and YOUR homes. (Nehemiah 4:14)
