Psalms 26:8" Yehowah, I have loved the dwelling of your house and the place of the residing of your glory.

- And the lamp of God was not yet extinguished, and Samuel was lying in the temple of Yehowah, where the ark of God was. (1 Samuel 3:3)
- Thus they brought the ark of the true God in and placed it inside the tent that David had pitched for it, and they began to present burnt offerings and communion sacrifices before the true God. (1 Chronicles 16:1)
- One thing I have asked from Yehowah. It is what I shall look for, that I may dwell in the house of Yehowah all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah and to look with appreciation upon his temple. (Psalms 27:4)
- For a day in your courtyards is better than a thousand elsewhere. I have chosen to stand at the threshold in the house of my God rather than to move around in the tents of wickedness. (Psalms 84:10)
- And the priests were not able to stand to minister because of the cloud, for the glory of Yehowah filled the house of the true God. (2 Chronicles 5:14)
- Thus I have beheld you in the holy place, at seeing your strength and your glory. (Psalms 63:2)
- But the king said to Zadok; Take the ark of the true God back to the city. If I shall find favor in the eyes of Yehowah, he will also certainly bring me back and let me see it and its abiding place. (2 Samuel 15:25)

of my God over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house. (1 Chronicles 29:3)
