Psalms 119:105... Your word is a lamp to my foot, and a light to my roadway.

- The feet of his loyal ones he guards, As for the wicked ones, they are silenced in darkness, for not by power does a man prove superior. (1 Samuel 2:9)
- Send out your light and your truth. May these themselves lead me. May they bring me to your holy mountain and to your grand tabernacle. (Psalms 43:3)
- For the commandment is a lamp, and a light the Law is, and the reproofs of discipline are the way of life. (Proverbs 6:23)
- Pay attention to me, O my people, and you national group of mine, to me give ear. For from me a Law itself will go forth, and my judicial decision I shall cause to repose even as a light to the peoples. (Isaiah 51:4)
- For all the things that were written aforetime were written for our instruction, that through our endurance and through the comfort from the Scriptures we might have hope. (Romans 15:4)
- All Scripture is inspired of God and beneficial for teaching, for reproving, for setting things straight, for disciplining in righteousness. (2 Timothy 3:16)
