- Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6)
- For this very reason also God exalted him to a superior position and kindly gave him the name that is above every other name. (Philippians 2:9)
- And whatever it is that you do in word or in work, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, thanking God the Father through him. (Colossians 3:17)
- The way of the wicked ones is like the gloom, they have not known at what they keep stumbling. (Proverbs 4:19)
