And the nations will certainly see your righteousness, O woman, and all kings your glory. And you will actually be called by a new name, which the very mouth of Yehowah will designate.

- But I want you to know that the head of every man is the Christ, in turn the head of a woman is the man, in turn the head of the Christ is God. (1 Corinthians 11:3)
- In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was with God, and the Word was a god. (John 1:1)
- This one was in the beginning with God. (John 1:2)
- He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. (Colossians 1:15)
- Because by means of him all other things were created in the heavens and upon the earth, the things visible and the things invisible, no matter whether they are thrones or lordships or governments or authorities. All other things have been created through him and for him. (Colossians 1:16)
- Also, he is before all other things and by means of him all other things were made to exist. (Colossians 1:17)
- And he is the head of the body, the congregation. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that he might become the one who is first in all things. (Colossians 1:18)
- And a great sign was seen in heaven, a woman arrayed with the sun, and the moon was beneath her feet, and on her head was a crown of twelve stars. (Revelation 12:1)
- And she was pregnant. And she cries out in her pains and in her agony to give birth. (Revelation 12:2)

- And your gates will actually be kept open constantly, they will not be closed even by day or by night, in order to bring to you the resources of the nations, and their kings will be taking the lead. (Isaiah 60:11)
