Messianic ··· Prophecy ··· Christ - Anyone slaughtering his companion in secrecy I silence, I cannot endure the arrogant and haughty (Psalms 101:5) [27] - References

Psalms 101:5... Anyone slandering his companion in secrecy, him I silence. Anyone of haughty eyes and of arrogant heart, him I cannot endure.

[27] - References

- You must not go around among your people for the sake of slandering. You must not stand up against your fellow's blood. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 19:16)
- You sit and speak against your own brother, against the son of your mother you give away a fault. (Psalms 50:20)
- He that is going about as a slanderer is uncovering confidential talk, and with one that is enticed with his lips you must have no fellowship. (Proverbs 20:19)
- Likewise let the aged women be reverent in behavior, not slanderous, neither enslaved to a lot of wine, teachers of what is good. (Titus 2:3)
- But now I am writing you to quit mixing in company with anyone called a brother that is a fornicator or a greedy person or an idolater or a reviler or a drunkard or an extortioner, not even eating with such a man. (1 Corinthians 5:11)
- Do not become unevenly yoked with unbelievers. For what fellowship do righteousness and Lawlessness have? Or what sharing does light have with darkness? (2 Corinthians 6:14)
- If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, never receive him into your homes or say a greeting to him. (2 John 1:10)
- Let flow the furious outbursts of your anger, and see every one haughty and bring him low. (Job 40:11)
- Because the afflicted people you yourself will save, but the haughty eyes you will abase. (Psalms 18:27)

- Lofty eyes, a false tongue, and hands that are shedding innocent blood. (Proverbs 6:17)
- The haughty eyes of earthling man must become low, and the loftiness of men must bow down, and Yehowah alone must be put on high in that day. (Isaiah 2:11)
- I tell you, this man went down to his home proved more righteous than that man, because everyone that exalts himself will be humiliated, but he that humbles himself will be exalted. (Luke 18:14)
- In like manner, you younger men, be in subjection to the older men. But all of you gird yourselves with lowliness of mind toward one another, because God opposes the haughty ones, but he gives undeserved kindness to the humble ones. (1 Peter 5:5)
- But if anyone is not obedient to our word through this letter, keep this one marked, stop associating with him, that he may become ashamed. (2 Thessalonians 3:14)
- And you must remember all the way that Yehowah your God made you walk these forty years in the wilderness, in order to humble you, to put you to the test so as to know what was in your heart, as to whether you would keep his commandments or not. (Deuteronomy 8:2)
- And David went on to say to Saul; Why do you listen to the words of man, saying; Look! David is seeking your hurt? (1 Samuel 24:9)
- So he slandered your servant to my lord the king. But my lord the king is as an angel of the true God, and so do what is good in your eyes. (2 Samuel 19:27)
- And the humble people you will save, but your eyes are against the haughty ones, that you may bring them low. (2 Samuel 22:28)
- He has not slandered with his tongue. To his companion he has done nothing bad, and no reproach has he taken up against his intimate acquaintance. (Psalms 15:3)
- The fear of Yehowah means the hating of bad. Self-exaltation and pride and the bad way and the perverse mouth I have hated. (Proverbs 8:13)
- Where there is one covering over hatred there are lips of falsehood, and the one bringing forth a bad report is stupid. (Proverbs 10:18)

- The one walking about as a slanderer is uncovering confidential talk, but the one faithful in spirit is covering over a matter. (Proverbs 11:13)
- Haughty eyes and an arrogant heart, the lamp of the wicked ones, are sin. (Proverbs 21:4)
- The wind from the north brings forth as with labor pains a downpour, and a tongue giving away a secret, a denounced face. (Proverbs 25:23)
- There is a generation whose eyes have become O how lofty! And whose beaming eyes are lifted up. (Proverbs 30:13)
- Those who are saying; Keep close to yourself. Do not approach me, for I shall certainly convey holiness to you. These are a smoke in my nostrils, a fire burning all day long. (Isaiah 65:5)
- That is why, if I come, I will call to remembrance his works which he goes on doing, chattering about us with wicked words. Also, not being content with these things, neither does he himself receive the brothers with respect, and those who are wanting to receive them he tries to hinder and to throw out of the congregation. (3 John 1:10)
