Psalms 34:11" Come, you sons, listen to me, the fear of Yehowah is what I shall teach you.

- Listen, O sons, to the discipline of a father and pay attention, so as to know understanding. (Proverbs 4:1)
- And he went on to say to man; Look! The fear of Yehowah, that is wisdom, and to turn away from bad is understanding. (Job 28:28)
- The fear of Yehowah is the beginning of wisdom. All those doing them have a good insight. His praise is standing forever. (Psalms 111:10)
- The fear of Yehowah is the beginning of knowledge. Wisdom and discipline are what mere fools have despised. (Proverbs 1:7)
- The fear of Yehowah means the hating of bad. Self-exaltation and pride and the bad way and the perverse mouth I have hated. (Proverbs 8:13)
