Isaiah 54:1" Cry out joyfully, you barren woman that did not give birth! Become cheerful with a joyful outcry and cry shrilly, you that had no childbirth pains, for the sons of the desolated one are more numerous than the sons of the woman with a husbandly owner, Yehowah has said.

- He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. (Colossians 1:15)
- Because by means of him all other things were created in the heavens and upon the earth, the things visible and the things invisible, no matter whether they are thrones or lordships or governments or authorities. All other things have been created through him and for him. (Colossians 1:16)
- · Also, he is before all other things and by means of him all other things were made to exist. (Colossians 1:17)
- And he is the head of the body, the congregation. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that he might become the one who is first in all things. (Colossians 1:18)
- And God went on to say; Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness, and let them have in subjection the fish of the sea and the flying creatures of the heavens and the domestic animals and all the earth and every moving animal that is moving upon the earth. (Genesis 1:26)

- No more will you be said to be a woman left entirely, and your own land will no more be said to be desolate, but you yourself will be called, My Delight Is in Her, and your land, Owned as a Wife. For Yehowah will have taken delight in you, and your own land will be owned as a wife. (Isaiah 62:4)
