- Do arise, O Yehowah. O God, lift up your hand. Do not forget the afflicted ones. (Psalms 10:12)
- Awake, awake, clothe yourself with strength, O arm of Yehowah! Awake as in the days of long ago, as during the generations of times long past. Are you not the one that broke Rahab to pieces, that pierced the sea monster? (Isaiah 51:9)
- Help me, O Yehowah my God, save me according to your loving-kindness. (Psalms 109:26)
- He has put his trust in God, let Him now rescue him if He wants him, for he said; I am God's Son. (Matthew 27:43)
- For to this end we are working hard and exerting ourselves, because we have rested our hope on a living God, who is a Savior of all sorts of men, especially of faithful ones. (1 Timothy 4:10)
- Do arouse yourself and awake to my judgment, O my God, even Yehowah, to my case at Law. (Psalms 35:23)
- Jesus said to her; Stop clinging to me. For I have not yet ascended to the Father. But be on your way to my brothers and say to them, I am ascending to my Father and YOUR Father and to my God and YOUR God. (John 20:17)
