Psalms 91:15... He will call upon me, and I shall answer him. I shall be with him in distress. I shall rescue him and glorify him.

[27] - References

- The desire of the meek ones you will certainly hear, O Yehowah. You will prepare their heart. You will pay attention with your ear. (Psalms 10:17)
- And call me in the day of distress. I shall rescue you, and you will glorify me. (Psalms 50:15)
- For everyone who calls on the name of Yehowah will be saved. (Romans 10:13)
- In the days of his flesh Christ offered up supplications and also petitions to the One who was able to save him out of death, with strong outcries and tears, and he was favorably heard for his godly fear. (Hebrews 5:7)
- If I should walk in the midst of distress, you will preserve me alive. Because of the anger of my enemies you will thrust out your hand, and your right hand will save me. (Psalms 138:7)
- In case you should pass through the waters, I will be with you, and through the rivers, they will not flood over you. In case you should walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, neither will the flame itself singe you. (Isaiah 43:2)
- That is why the utterance of Yehowah the God of Israel is; I did indeed say, As for your house and the house of your forefather, they will walk before me to time indefinite. But now the utterance of Yehowah is; It is unthinkable, on my part, because those honoring me I shall honor, and those despising me will be of little account. (1 Samuel 2:30)

- Who through him are believers in God, the one who raised him up from the dead and gave him glory, so that YOUR faith and hope might be in God. (1 Peter 1:21)
- Samson now called to Yehowah and said; Sovereign Lord Yehowah, remember me, please, and strengthen me, please, just this once, O you the true God, and let me avenge myself upon the Philistines with vengeance for one of my two eyes. (Judges 16:28)
- And it came about that, as soon as the chiefs of the chariots saw Jehoshaphat, they, for their part, said to themselves; Surely it is the king of Israel. So they turned aside against him to fight, and Jehoshaphat began to cry for aid. (1 Kings 22:32)
- And Elisha began to pray and say; O Yehowah, open his eyes, please, that he may see. Immediately Yehowah opened the attendant's eyes, so that he saw, and, look! The mountainous region was full of horses and war chariots of fire all around Elisha. (2 Kings 6:17)
- Then David built there an altar to Yehowah and offered up burnt sacrifices and communion sacrifices, and he proceeded to call upon Yehowah, who now answered him with fire from the heavens upon the altar of burnt offering. (1 Chronicles 21:26)
- Whatever prayer, whatever request for favor there may occur on the part of any man or of all your people Israel, because they know each one his own plague and his own pain, when he actually spreads out his palms toward this house. (2 Chronicles 6:29)
- One who is a laughingstock to his fellowman I become, one calling to God that he should answer him. A laughingstock is the righteous, unblamable one. (Job 12:4)
- They cried out, and Yehowah himself heard, and out of all their distresses he delivered them. (Psalms 34:17)
- And the salvation of the righteous ones is from Yehowah, he is their fortress in the time of distress. (Psalms 37:39)
- As for me, to God I shall call out, and Yehowah himself will save me. (Psalms 55:16)
- In distress you called, and I proceeded to rescue you, I began to answer you in the concealed place of thunder. I went examining you at the waters of Meribah. (Psalms 81:7)

- And they kept crying out to Yehowah in their distress, out of the stresses upon them he proceeded to deliver them. (Psalms 107:6)
- The desire of those fearing him he will perform, and their cry for help he will hear, and he will save them. (Psalms 145:19)
- And they proceeded to say to him; This is what Hezekiah has said; This day is a day of distress and of rebuke and of scornful insolence, for the sons have come as far as the womb's mouth, and there is no power to give birth. (Isaiah 37:3)
- At that Hezekiah turned his face to the wall and began to pray to Yehowah (Isaiah 38:2)
- And it will actually occur that before they call out I myself shall answer, while they are yet speaking, I myself shall hear. (Isaiah 65:24)
- Call to me, and I shall answer you and readily tell you great and incomprehensible things that you have not known. (Jeremiah 33:3)
- To you, O Yehowah, I shall call, for fire itself has devoured the pasture grounds of the wilderness, and a very flame has consumed all the trees of the field. (Joel 1:19)
- Then Jonah prayed to Yehowah his God from the inward parts of the fish (Jonah 2:1)
- Yehowah is good, a stronghold in the day of distress. And he is cognizant of those seeking refuge in him. (Nahum 1:7)
