- But you have approached a Mount Zion and a city of the living God, heavenly Jerusalem, and myriads of angels. (Hebrews 12:22)
- And I saw, and, look! The Lamb standing upon the Mount Zion, and with him a hundred and forty-four thousand having his name and the name of his Father written on their foreheads. (Revelation 14:1)
- The stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (Psalms 118:22)
- As it is written; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense, but he that rests his faith on it will not come to disappointment. (Romans 9:33)
- For it is contained in Scripture: Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one exercising faith in it will by any means come to disappointment. (1 Peter 2:6)
- For it was fitting for the one for whose sake all things are and through whom all things are, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the Chief Agent of their salvation perfect through sufferings. (Hebrews 2:10)
- And after he had been made perfect he became responsible for everlasting salvation to all those obeying him. (Hebrews 5:9)
- Jesus said to them; Did you never read in the Scriptures: The stone that the builders rejected is the one that has become the chief

cornerstone. From Yehowah this has come to be, and it is marvelous in our eyes? (Matthew 21:42)

- Did you never read this scripture: The stone that the builders rejected, this has become the chief cornerstone. (Mark 12:10)
- But he looked upon them and said; What, then, does this that is written mean: The stone which the builders rejected, this has become the chief cornerstone? (Luke 20:17)
- This is the stone that was treated by you builders as of no account that has become the head of the corner. (Acts of Apostles 4:11)
- And I shall put my words in your mouth, and with the shadow of my hand I shall certainly cover you, in order to plant the heavens and lay the foundation of the earth and say to Zion, You are my people. (Isaiah 51:16)
- · Also, I say to you; You are Peter. And on this rock-mass I will build my congregation, and the gates of Hades will not overpower it. (Matthew 16:18)
- For no man can lay any other foundation than what is laid, which is Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 3:11)
- And you have been built up upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, while Christ Jesus himself is the foundation cornerstone. (Ephesians 2:20)
- As it is written; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense, but he that rests his faith on it will not come to disappointment. (Romans 9:33)
- For the Scripture says; None that rests his faith on him will be disappointed. (Romans 10:11)
- For it is contained in Scripture: Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one exercising faith in it will by any means come to disappointment. (1 Peter 2:6)
- And yet his bow was dwelling in a permanent place, and the strength of his hands was supple. From the hands of the powerful one of Jacob, from there is the shepherd, the stone of Israel. (Genesis 49:24)

- Accordingly the king commanded that they should quarry great stones, expensive stones, to lay the foundation of the house with hewn stones. (1 Kings 5:17)
- And he must become as a sacred place, but as a stone to strike against and as a rock over which to stumble to both the houses of Israel, as a trap and as a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 8:14)
- And what will anyone say in answer to the messengers of the nation? That Yehowah himself has laid the foundation of Zion, and in her the afflicted ones of his people will take refuge. (Isaiah 14:32)
- For it is not Sheol that can laud you, death itself cannot praise you. Those going down into the pit cannot look hopefully to your trueness. (Isaiah 38:18)
- Look! The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself will help me. Who is there that can pronounce me wicked? Look! All of them, like a garment, will wear out. A mere moth will eat them up. (Isaiah 50:9)
- For you people will get out in no panic, and you will go in no flight. For Yehowah will be going even before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard. (Isaiah 52:12)
- For I myself, Yehowah, shall speak what word I shall speak, and it will be done. There will be no postponement anymore, for in YOUR days, O rebellious house, I shall speak a word and certainly do it, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 12:25)
- Forasmuch as you beheld that out of the mountain a stone was cut not by hands, and that it crushed the iron, the copper, the molded clay, the silver and the gold. The grand God himself has made known to the king what is to occur after this. And the dream is reliable, and the interpretation of it is trustworthy. (Daniel 2:45)
- For, look! The stone that I have put before Joshua! Upon the one stone there are seven eyes. Here I am engraving its engraving, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and I will take away the error of that land in one day. (Zechariah 3:9)
- Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you will become a level land. And he will certainly bring forth the headstone. There will be shoutings to it; How charming! How charming! (Zechariah 4:7)
