- And now this is what you will say to my servant David; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; I myself took you from the pasture ground from following the flock to become a leader over my people Israel. (2 Samuel 7:8)
- From the day that I brought my people Israel out from Egypt I have not chosen a city out of all the tribes of Israel to build a house for my name to continue there, but I shall choose David to come to be over my people Israel. (1 Kings 8:16)
- Look! My servant, on whom I keep fast hold! My chosen one, whom my soul has approved! I have put my spirit in him. Justice to the nations is what he will bring forth. (Isaiah 42:1)
- This one will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and Yehowah God will give him the throne of David his father. (Luke 1:32)
- Yehowah has sworn to David, truly he will not draw back from it; Of the fruitage of your belly I shall set on your throne. (Psalms 132:11)
- And they will certainly serve Yehowah their God and David their king, whom I shall raise up for them. (Jeremiah 30:9)
