Psalms 119:106. I have made a sworn statement, and I will carry it out, to keep your righteous judicial decisions.

[12] - References

- So they swore to Yehowah with a loud voice and with joyful shouting and with the trumpets and with horns. (2 Chronicles 15:14)
- They were adhering to their brothers, their majestic ones, and coming into liability to a curse and into an oath, to walk in the Law of the true God, which had been given by the hand of Moses the servant of the true God, and to keep and to perform all the commandments of Yehowah our Lord and his judicial decisions and his regulations. (Nehemiah 10:29)
- I shall come into your house with whole burnt offerings, I shall pay to you my vows (Psalms 66:13)
- Again you heard that it was said to those of ancient times: You must not swear without performing, but you must pay your vows to Yehowah. (Matthew 5:33)
- And you must keep my statutes and my judicial decisions, which if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 18:5)
- Then he spoke to Korah and to his entire assembly, saying; In the morning Yehowah will make known who belongs to him and who is holy and who must come near to him, and whoever he may choose will come near to him. (Numbers 16:5)
- Not one among these men of this evil generation will see the good land that I swore to give to YOUR fathers. (Deuteronomy 1:35)
- And it must occur that, because you continue listening to these judicial decisions and you do keep them and do carry them out, Yehowah your God must keep toward you the covenant and the loving-

kindness about which he swore to your forefathers. (Deuteronomy 7:12)

- In case a man makes a vow to Yehowah or swears an oath to bind a vow of abstinence upon his soul, he must not violate his word. According to all that has gone out of his mouth he should do. (Numbers 30:2)
- And the king kept standing in his place and proceeded to conclude the covenant before Yehowah to go following Yehowah and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his regulations with all his heart and with all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant that were written in this book. (2 Chronicles 34:31)
- Also, my bosom I shook out and then said; In this manner may the true God shake out from his house and from his acquired property every man that does not carry out this word, and in this manner may he become shaken out and empty. To this all the congregation said; Amen! And they began to praise Yehowah. And the people proceeded to do according to this word. (Nehemiah 5:13)
- And you yourselves turn around today and do what is upright in my eyes in proclaiming liberty each one to his companion, and you conclude a covenant before me in the house upon which my name has been called. (Jeremiah 34:15)
