- But as for me, here I have made you today a fortified city and an iron pillar and copper walls against all the land, toward the kings of Judah, toward her princes, toward her priests and toward the people of the land. (Jeremiah 1:18)
- Like a diamond, harder than flint, I have made your forehead. You must not be afraid of them, and you must not be struck with terror at their faces, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 3:9)
- But Yehowah was with me like a terrible mighty one. That is why the very ones persecuting me will stumble and not prevail.
