Psalms 145:1" I will exalt you, O my God the King, and I will bless your name to time indefinite, even forever.

- You yourself are my King, O God. Command grand salvation for Jacob. (Psalms 44:4)
- For Yehowah is our Judge, Yehowah is our Statute-giver, Yehowah is our King, he himself will save us. (Isaiah 33:22)
- The king was answering Daniel and saying; Truly the God of You men is a God of gods and a Lord of kings and a Revealer of secrets, because you were able to reveal this secret. (Daniel 2:47)
- Saying; We thank you, Yehowah God, the Almighty, the One who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and begun ruling as king. (Revelation 11:17)
- Consequently David blessed Yehowah before the eyes of all the congregation and David said; Blessed may you be, O Yehowah the God of Israel our father, from time indefinite even to time indefinite. (1 Chronicles 29:10)
