Psalms 43:1" Judge me, O God, and do conduct my legal case against a nation not loyal. From the man of deception and unrighteousness may you provide me with escape.

- Yehowah himself will pass sentence on the peoples. Judge me, O Yehowah, according to my righteousness and according to my integrity in me. (Psalms 7:8)
- Judge me, O Yehowah, for I myself have walked in my own integrity, and in Yehowah I have trusted, that I may not wobble. (Psalms 26:1)
- Judge me according to your righteousness, O Yehowah my God, and may they not rejoice over me. (Psalms 35:24)
- And Yehowah must become judge, and he must judge between me and you, and he will see and he will conduct the legal case for me and judge me to free me from your hand. (1 Samuel 24:15)
- Do conduct my case, O Yehowah, against my opponents, war against those warring against me. (Psalms 35:1)
