Psalms 119:80· Let my heart prove faultless in your regulations, in order, that I may not be ashamed.

[11] - References

- This day Yehowah your God is commanding you to carry out these **regulations** and judicial decisions, and you must observe and carry them out with all your **heart** and all your soul. (Deuteronomy 26:16)
- So as to incline our **heart** to himself to walk in all his ways and to keep his commandments and his **regulations** and his judicial decisions, which he gave in command to our forefathers. (1 Kings 8:58)
- I have inclined my **heart** to do your **regulations** to time indefinite, down to the last. (Psalms 119:112)
- Then the eyes of both of them became opened and they began to realize that they were naked. Hence they sewed fig leaves together and made loin coverings for themselves. (Genesis 3:7)
- O my God, in you have I put my trust, O may I not be **ashamed**. May my enemies not exult over me. (Psalms 25:2)
- In that case I should not be **ashamed**, when I look to all your commandments. (Psalms 119:6)
- So now, little children, remain in union with him, that when he is made manifest we may have freeness of speech and not be shamed away from him at his presence. (1 John 2:28)
- And **you** people must keep all my statutes and all my judicial decisions and do them, that the land to which I am bringing **you** to dwell in it may not vomit **you** out. (Leviticus 20:22)
- And now fear Yehowah and serve him in faultlessness and in truth, and remove the gods that **your** forefathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt, and serve Yehowah. (Joshua 24:14)

- And he went on walking in all the sins of his father that he did prior to him, and his heart did not prove to be complete with Yehowah his God, like the heart of David his forefather. (**1 Kings 15:3**)
- I have cleaved to your reminders. O Yehowah, do not put me to shame. (**Psalms 119:31**)
