Jeremiah 17:18. Let my persecutors be put to shame, but let me personally be put to no shame. Let them be the ones to be struck with terror, but let me personally not be struck with terror. Bring upon them the day of calamity, and break them even with twice as much breakdown.

[10] - References

- May those be shamed and humiliated who are hunting for my soul. May those be turned back and be abashed who are scheming calamity for me. (Psalms 35:4)
- You yourself have known. O Yehowah, remember me and turn your attention to me and avenge me upon my persecutors. In your slowness to anger do not take me away. Take note of my bearing reproach on account of your own self. (Jeremiah 15:15)
- But Yehowah was with me like a terrible mighty one. That is why the very ones persecuting me will stumble and not prevail. They will certainly be put to much shame, because they will not have prospered. Their indefinitely lasting humiliation will be one that will not be forgotten. (Jeremiah 20:11)
- O my God, in you have I put my trust, O may I not be ashamed. May my enemies not exult over me. (Psalms 25:2)
- But you yourself, O Yehowah, well know all their counsel against me for my death. Do not cover over their error, and do not wipe out that sin of theirs from before you, but let them become those who are made to stumble before you. In the time of your anger take action against them. (Jeremiah 18:23)
- And, first of all, I will repay the full amount of their error and of their sin, on account of their profaning my land. With the corpses of their disgusting things and their detestable things they had filled my inheritance. (Jeremiah 16:18)

- In you, O Yehowah, I have taken refuge. O may I never be ashamed. (Psalms 71:1)
- But you, O Yehowah of armies, are examining the righteous one, you are seeing the kidneys and the heart. May I see your vengeance upon them, for to you I have revealed my case at Law. (Jeremiah 20:12)
- Like a diamond, harder than flint, I have made your forehead. You must not be afraid of them, and you must not be struck with terror at their faces, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 3:9)
