CHRIST - LOOK I HAVE MADE YOU A THRESHING SLEDGE

Messianic ··· Prophecy ··· Christ - Look I have made you a threshing sledge having double edged teeth, you will tread down the nations and crush them and the lesser governments you will make just like chaff · (Isaiah 41:15) [18] - References

Look! I have made you a threshing sledge, a new threshing instrument having double-edged teeth. You will tread down the mountains and crush them, and the hills you will make just like the chaff.

- At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the chaff from the summer threshing floor, and the wind carried them away so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole earth. (Daniel 2:35)
- And in the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be brought to ruin. And the kingdom itself will not be passed on to any other people. It will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it itself will stand to times indefinite. (Daniel 2:44)
- With denunciation you went marching through the earth. In anger you went threshing the nations. (Habakkuk 3:12)
- His winnowing shovel is in his hand, and he will completely clean up his threshing floor, and will gather his wheat into the storehouse, but the chaff he will burn up with fire that cannot be put out. (Matthew 3:12)
- The wicked are not like that, but are like the chaff that the wind drives away. (Psalms 1:4)
- May they become like chaff before the wind, and let Yehowah's angel be pushing them along. (Psalms 35:5)
- O my God, make them like a thistle whirl, like stubble before a wind. (Psalms 83:13)

- Where is the king of Hamath and the king of Arpad and the king of the city of Sepharvaim, of Hena and of Ivvah? (Isaiah 37:13)
- And I began to see, and, look! There was a tempestuous wind coming from the north, a great cloud mass and quivering fire, and it had a brightness all around, and out of the midst of it there was something like the look of electrum, out of the midst of the fire. (Ezekiel 1:4)
- As pointed earthenware fragments are its underparts, it spreads out a threshing instrument upon the mire. (Job 41:30)
- For it is not with a threshing instrument that black cumin is given a treading, and upon cumin no wheel of a wagon is turned. For it is with a rod that black cumin is generally beaten out, and cumin with a staff. (Isaiah 28:27)
- And Yehowah will certainly make the dignity of his voice to be heard and will make the descending of his arm to be seen, in the raging of anger and the flame of a devouring fire and cloudburst and rainstorm and hailstones. (Isaiah 30:30)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; The daughter of Babylon is like a threshing floor. It is the time to tread her down solid. Yet a little while and the time of the harvest must come for her. (Jeremiah 51:33)
- Get up and thresh, O daughter of Zion, for your horn I shall change into iron, and your hoofs I shall change into copper, and you will certainly pulverize many peoples, and by a ban you will actually devote to Yehowah their unjust profit, and their resources to the true Lord of the whole earth. (Micah 4:13)
- And the remaining ones of Jacob must become among the nations, in the midst of many peoples, like a lion among the beasts of a forest, like a maned young lion among droves of sheep, which, when it actually passes through, certainly both tramples down and tears in pieces, and there is no deliverer. (Micah 5:8)
- For I will tread as my bow Judah. The bow I will fill with Ephraim, and I will awaken your sons, O Zion, against your sons, O Greece, and I will make you as the sword of a mighty man. (Zechariah 9:13)
- In that day I shall make the sheiks of Judah like a firepot among trees and like a fiery torch in a row of newly cut grain, and they must devour on the right hand and on the left all the peoples round about,

and Jerusalem must yet be inhabited in her own place, in Jerusalem. (Zechariah 12:6)

After this I saw four angels standing upon the four corners of the earth, holding tight the four winds of the earth, that no wind might blow upon the earth or upon the sea or upon any tree. (Revelation 7:1)
