Isaiah 42:1· Look! My servant, on whom I keep fast hold! My chosen one, whom my soul has approved! I have put my spirit in him. Justice to the nations is what he will bring forth.

- Look! My **servant will** act with insight. He **will** be in high station and **will** certainly be elevated and exalted very much. (Isaiah 52:13)
- Look! My **servant** whom I chose, my beloved, whom my **soul approved!** I **will put** my **spirit** upon him, and **what** justice is he **will** make clear to the **nations**. (Matthew 12:18)
- Because I **have** come down from heaven to do, not my **will**, but the **will** of him that sent me. (John 6:38)
- This is **what** Yehowah, the Repurchaser of Israel, his Holy One, **has** said to him that is despised in **soul**, to him that is detested by the nation, to the **servant** of rulers; Kings themselves **will** see and certainly rise up, and princes, and they **will** bow down, by reason of Yehowah, who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel, who chooses you. (Isaiah 49:7)
- At that time you spoke in a vision to your loyal ones, and you proceeded to say; I **have** placed help upon a mighty one, I **have** exalted a **chosen** one from among the people. (Psalms 89:19)
- I **have** found David my **servant**, with my holy oil I **have** anointed him. (Psalms 89:20)
- Work, not for the food that perishes, but for the food that remains for life everlasting, which the Son of man **will** give **you**, for upon this one the Father, even God, **has put** his seal of approval. (John 6:27)

- Coming to him as to a living stone, rejected, it is true, by men, but **chosen**, precious, with God. (**1 Peter 2:4**)
- And they began to remove the foreign gods from their midst and to serve Yehowah, so that his **soul** became impatient because of the trouble of Israel. (**Judges 10:16**)
- I **have** concluded a covenant toward my **chosen** one, I **have** sworn to David my **servant**. (**Psalms 89:3**)
- With whom my own hand **will** be firm, whom my own arm also **will** strengthen. (**Psalms 89:21**)
- In the path of righteousness I walk, in the middle of the roadways of judgment. (**Proverbs 8:20**)
- Then I came to be beside him as a master worker, and I came to be the one he was specially fond of day by day, I being glad before him all the time. (**Proverbs 8:30**)
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there **will** be no end, upon the throne of David and upon his kingdom in order to establish it firmly and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of Yehowah of armies **will** do this. (**Isaiah 9:7**)
- And upon him the **spirit** of Yehowah must settle down, the **spirit** of wisdom and of understanding, the **spirit** of counsel and of mightiness, the **spirit** of knowledge and of the fear of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 11:2**)
- For **what** reason do you say, O Jacob, and do you speak out, O Israel, My way **has** been concealed from Yehowah, and justice to me eludes my God himself? (**Isaiah 40:27**)
- Who among **you** people is in fear of Yehowah, listening to the voice of his **servant**, who **has** walked in continual darkness and for whom there **has** been no brightness? Let him trust in the name of Yehowah and support himself upon his God. (**Isaiah 50:10**)
- Because of the trouble of his **soul** he **will** see, he **will** be satisfied. By means of his knowledge the righteous one, my **servant**, **will bring** a righteous standing to many people, and their errors he himself **will** bear. (**Isaiah 53:11**)
- The **spirit** of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah is upon me, for the reason that Yehowah **has** anointed me to tell Good News to the meek ones. He **has** sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty

to those taken captive and the wide opening of the eyes even to the prisoners. (**Isaiah 61:1**)

• In that day, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, I shall take you, O Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, my servant, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I shall certainly set you as a seal ring, because you are the one whom I **have** chosen, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. (**Haggai 2:23**)

• Hear, please, O Joshua the High Priest, you and your companions who are sitting before you, for they are men serving as portents, for here I am bringing in my **servant** Sprout! (**Zechariah 3:8**)

• Look! Also, there was a voice from the heavens that said; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I **have** approved. (**Matthew 3:17**)

• While he was yet speaking, look! A bright cloud overshadowed them, and, look! A voice out of the cloud, saying; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I **have approved**, listen to him. (**Matthew 17:5**)

• And immediately on coming up out of the water he saw the heavens being parted, and, like a dove, the **spirit** coming down upon him. (**Mark 1:10**)

• And a cloud formed, overshadowing them, and a voice came out of the cloud; This is my Son, the beloved, listen to him. (**Mark 9:7**)

• That you **have** made ready in the sight of all the peoples. (**Luke 2:31**)

• And a voice came out of the cloud, saying; This is my Son, the one that **has** been **chosen**. Listen to him. (**Luke 9:35**)

• Then concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world **has** been judged. (**John 16:11**)

• Namely, Jesus who was from Nazareth, how God anointed him with Holy Spirit and power, and he went through the land doing good and healing all those oppressed by the Devil, because God was with him. (**Acts of Apostles 10:38**)
