Nahum 1:15... Look! Upon the mountains the feet of one bringing Good News, one publishing peace. O Judah, celebrate your festivals. Pay your vows, because no more will any good-for-nothing person pass again through you. In his entirety he will certainly be cut off.

- How comely upon the mountains are the feet of the one bringing Good News, the one publishing peace, the one bringing Good News of something better, the one publishing salvation, the one saying to Zion; Your God has become king! (Isaiah 52:7)
- But the angel said to them; Have no fear, for, look! I am declaring to You Good News of a great joy that all the people will have. (Luke 2:10)
- Three times in the year every male of yours should appear before Yehowah your God in the place that he will choose, in the festival of the unfermented cakes and in the festival of weeks and in the festival of booths, and none should appear before Yehowah empty-handed. (Deuteronomy 16:16)
- For the layer bread and the constant grain offering and the constant burnt offering of the Sabbaths, the new moons, for the appointed feasts and for the holy things and for the sin offerings to make atonement for Israel and all the work of the house of our God. (Nehemiah 10:33)
- My vows I shall pay to Yehowah, yes, in front of all his people. (Psalms 116:14)
- Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more will there come again into you the uncircumcised and unclean one. (Isaiah 52:1)

- And just a little while longer, and the wicked one will be no more, and you will certainly give attention to his place, and he will not be. (Psalms 37:10)
- Let his posterity be for cutting off. In the following generation let their name be wiped out. (Psalms 109:13)
- And these will depart into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life. (Matthew 25:46)
- In case a man makes a vow to Yehowah or swears an oath to bind a vow of abstinence upon his soul, he must not violate his word. According to all that has gone out of his mouth he should do. (Numbers 30:2)
- In case you vow a vow to Yehowah your God, you must not be slow about paying it, because Yehowah your God will without fail require it of you, and it would indeed become a sin on your part. (Deuteronomy 23:21)
- While they were making their hearts feel good, look! The men of the city, mere good-for-nothing men, surrounded the house, shoving one another against the door, and they kept saying to the old man, the owner of the house; Bring out the man that came into your house, that we may have intercourse with him. (Judges 19:22)
- As for the good-for-nothing men, they said; How will this one save us? Accordingly they despised him, and they did not bring any gift to him. But he continued like one grown speechless. (1 Samuel 10:27)
- However, every bad and good-for-nothing man out of the men that had gone with David answered and kept saying; For the reason that they did not go with us, we will give them none of the spoil that we delivered, except to each one his wife and his sons, and let them lead them and go. (1 Samuel 30:22)
- But good-for-nothing persons are chased away, like thornbushes, all of them, for it is not by the hand that they should be taken. (2 Samuel 23:6)
- Finally they began to say the one to the other; It is not right what we are doing. This day is a day of Good News! If we are hesitating, and we actually wait until the morning light, guilt must also catch up with us. So now come and let us enter and make report at the king's house. (2 Kings 7:9)

- And you people will have to know that I am Yehowah YOUR God, residing in Zion my holy mountain. And Jerusalem must become a holy place, and as regards strangers, they will no more pass through her. (Joel 3:17)
- He sent out the word to the sons of Israel to declare to them the Good News of peace through Jesus Christ; this One is Lord of all others. (Acts of Apostles 10:36)
- How, in turn, will they preach unless they have been sent forth? Just as it is written: How comely are the feet of those who declare Good News of good things! (Romans 10:15)
