**Psalms 131:1** O Yehowah, my heart has not been haughty, nor have my eyes been lofty, nor have I walked in things too great, nor in things too wonderful for me.

- That his **heart** may not exalt itself above his brothers and that he may not turn aside from the commandment to the right or to the left, in order, that he may lengthen his days upon his kingdom, he and his sons in the midst of Israel. (**Deuteronomy 17:20**)
- And the people will certainly know it, even all of them, Ephraim and the inhabitant of Samaria, because of their haughtiness and because of their insolence of **heart** in saying; (**Isaiah 9:9**)
- But when his **heart** became **haughty** and his own spirit became hard, so as to act presumptuously, he was brought down from the throne of his kingdom, and his own dignity was taken away from him. (**Daniel 5:20**)
- In like manner, **you** younger men, be in subjection to the older men. But all of **you** gird yourselves with lowliness of mind toward one another, because God opposes the **haughty** ones, but he gives undeserved kindness to the humble ones. (**1 Peter 5:5**)
- And the servants of Saul began to speak these words in the ears of David, but David said; Is it an easy thing in **your eyes** to form a marriage alliance with the king, when I am a man of little means and lightly esteemed? (**1 Samuel 18:23**)
- For Yehowah is high, and yet the humble one he sees, but the **lofty** one he knows only from a distance. (**Psalms 138:6**)
- Lofty **eyes**, a false tongue, and hands that are shedding innocent blood. (**Proverbs 6:17**)

- And so he chose David his servant and took him from the pens of the flock. (**Psalms 78:70**)
- But as for you, you keep seeking **great things** for yourself. Do not keep on seeking. For here I am bringing in a calamity upon all flesh, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will give you your soul as a spoil in all the places to which you may go. (**Jeremiah 45:5**)
- Then Amos answered and said to Amaziah; I was not a prophet, neither was I the son of a prophet, but I was a herdsman and a nipper of figs of sycamore trees. (**Amos 7:14**)
- Be minded the same way toward others as to yourselves, do not be minding **lofty things**, but be led along with the lowly **things**. Do not become discreet in **YOUR** own **eyes**. (**Romans 12:16**)
- Who is this that is obscuring counsel without knowledge? Therefore I talked, but I was not understanding **things** too **wonderful** for me, which I do not know. (**Job 42:3**)
- Such knowledge is too **wonderful** for me. It is so high up that I cannot attain to it. (**Psalms 139:6**)
- Afterward Mordecai returned to the king's gate. As for Haman, he hurried to his house, mourning and with his head covered. (**Esther 6:12**)
- Do not do yourself honor before the king, and in the place of **great** ones do not stand (**Proverbs 25:6**)
