Zechariah 13:7· O sword, awake against my shepherd, even against the able-bodied man who is my associate, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. Strike the shepherd, and let those of the flock be scattered, and I shall certainly turn my hand back upon those who are insignificant.

- And I will raise up over them one **shepherd**, and he must feed them, **even** my servant David. He himself will feed them, and he himself will become their **shepherd**. (Ezekiel 34:23)
- And he will **certainly** stand and do shepherding in the strength of **Yehowah**, in the superiority of the name of **Yehowah** his God. And they will **certainly** keep dwelling, for now he will be great as far as the ends of the earth. (Micah 5:4)
- In that hour Jesus said to the crowds; Have **you** come out with **swords** and clubs as **against** a robber to arrest me? Day after day I used to sit in the temple teaching, and yet **you** did not take me into custody. (Matthew 26:55)
- I am the fine **shepherd**, the fine **shepherd** surrenders his soul in behalf of the sheep. (John 10:11)
- Now may the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great **shepherd** of the sheep with the blood of an everlasting covenant, our Lord Jesus. (Hebrews 13:20)
- And when the chief **shepherd** has been made manifest, **you** will receive the unfadable crown of glory. (1 Peter 5:4)
- Then I came to be beside him as a master worker, and I came to be the one he was specially fond of day by day, I being glad before him all the time. (Proverbs 8:30)

- That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have viewed attentively and our **hands** felt, concerning the word of life. (**1 John 1:1**)
- I came out from the Father and have come into the world. Further, I am leaving the world and am going my way to the Father. (**John 16:28**)
- So now you, Father, glorify me alongside yourself with the glory that I had alongside you before the world was. (**John 17:5**)
- Because of restraint and of judgment he was taken away, and who will concern himself **even** with the details of his generation? For he was severed from the land of the living ones. Because of the transgression of my people he had the stroke. (**Isaiah 53:8**)
- And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah will be cut off, with nothing for himself. And the city and the holy place the people of a leader that is coming will bring to their ruin. And the end of it will be by the flood. And until the end there will be war, what is decided upon is desolations. (**Daniel 9:26**)
- And Jesus said to them; **You** will all be stumbled, because it is written: I will strike the **shepherd**, and the sheep will be **scattered** about. (**Mark 14:27**)
- But in this way God has fulfilled the things he announced beforehand through the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer. (**Acts of Apostles 3:18**)
- And all those who dwell on the earth will worship it, the name of not one of them stands written in the scroll of life of the Lamb who was slaughtered, from the founding of the world. (**Revelation 13:8**)
- Then Jesus said to them; All of **you** will be stumbled in connection with me on this night, for it is written: I will strike the **shepherd**, and the sheep of the **flock** will be **scattered** about. (**Matthew 26:31**)
- And they all abandoned him and fled. (**Mark 14:50**)
- Look! The hour is coming, indeed, it has come, when **you** will be **scattered** each one to his own house and **you** will leave me alone, and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. (**John 16:32**)
- And I will **turn back** my **hand** upon you, and I shall smelt away your scummy dross as with lye, and I will remove all your waste products. (**Isaiah 1:25**)

- At that time Jesus said in response; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and intellectual ones and have revealed them to babes. (Matthew 11:25)

- But God chose the foolish things of the world, that he might put the wise men to shame, and God chose the weak things of the world, that he might put the strong things to shame. (1 Corinthians 1:27)

- So he said; I **certainly** see all the Israelites **scattered** on the mountains, like sheep that have no **shepherd**. And **Yehowah** went on to say; These have no masters. Let them go **back** each one to his house in peace. (1 Kings 22:17)

- But you, you have cast off and you keep contemning, you have become furious toward your anointed one. (Psalms 89:38)

- And you must say to him; This is what **Yehowah** of **armies** has said; Here is the **man** whose name is Sprout. And from his own place he will sprout, and he will **certainly** build the temple of **Yehowah**. (Zechariah 6:12)

- Those who took Jesus into custody led him away to Caiaphas the High Priest, where the scribes and the older men were gathered together. (Matthew 26:57)

- Then he took the twelve aside and said to them; Look! We are going up to Jerusalem, and all the things written by means of the prophets as to the Son of **man** will be completed. (Luke 18:31)

- They now arranged for a day with him, and they came in greater numbers to him in his lodging place. And he explained the matter to them by bearing thorough witness concerning the kingdom of God and by using persuasion with them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening. (Acts of Apostles 28:23)
