Psalms 7:1" O Yehowah my God, in you I have taken refuge. Save me from all those persecuting me and deliver me.

[14] - References

- Do arise, O Yehowah! Save me, O my God! For you will have to strike all my enemies on the jaw. The teeth of wicked ones you will have to break. (Psalms 3:7)
- Do arouse yourself and awake to my judgment, O my God, even Yehowah, to my case at Law. (Psalms 35:23)
- Yehowah is my crag and my stronghold and the Provider of escape for me. My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of salvation, my secure height. (Psalms 18:2)
- The name of Yehowah is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (Proverbs 18:10)
- My times are in your hand. Deliver me from the hand of my enemies and from those pursuing me. (Psalms 31:15)
- You yourself have known. O Yehowah, remember me and turn your attention to me and avenge me upon my persecutors. In your slowness to anger do not take me away. Take note of my bearing reproach on account of your own self. (Jeremiah 15:15)
- To the contrary, in all these things we are coming off completely victorious through him that loved us. (Romans 8:37)
- We are persecuted, but not left in the lurch, we are thrown down, but not destroyed. (2 Corinthians 4:9)
- Yehowah knows how to deliver people of godly devotion out of trial, but to reserve unrighteous people for the day of judgment to be cut off. (2 Peter 2:9)
