Psalms 31:17· O Yehowah, may I not be ashamed, for I have called on you. May the wicked ones be ashamed, may they keep silent in Sheol.

- O my God, in you **have** I put my trust, O may I not be **ashamed**. May my enemies not exult over me. (**Psalms 25:2**)
- O may those hoping in you not be **ashamed** because of me, O Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies. O may those seeking you not be humiliated because of me, O God of Israel. (**Psalms 69:6**)
- But the Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself will help me. That is why I shall not **have** to feel humiliated. That is why I **have** set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be **ashamed**. (**Isaiah 50:7**)
- About the ninth hour Jesus **called** out with a loud voice, saying; Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is, My God, my God, why **have** you forsaken me? (**Matthew 27:46**)
- Hear, O our God, for we **have** become an object of contempt, and make their reproach return upon their own head, and give them to the plunder in the land of captivity. (**Nehemiah 4:4**)
- And it came about that, as soon as all our enemies heard of it and all the nations that were around us got to see it, they at once fell very much in their own eyes, and they got to know that it was from our God that this work had been done. (**Nehemiah 6:16**)
- All my enemies will be very much **ashamed** and disturbed, they will turn back, they will be **ashamed** instantly. (**Psalms 6:10**)
- Look! All those getting heated up against you will become **ashamed** and be humiliated. The men in a quarrel with you will become as nothing and will perish. (**Isaiah 41:11**)
- But Yehowah was with me like a terrible mighty one. That is why the very **ones** persecuting me will stumble and not prevail. They will

certainly be put to much shame, because they will not **have** prospered. Their indefinitely lasting humiliation will be one that will not be forgotten. (**Jeremiah 20:11**)

- The feet of his loyal **ones** he guards. As for the **wicked ones**, they are silenced in darkness, for not by power does a man prove superior. (**1 Samuel 2:9**)

- The dead themselves do not praise Yah, nor do any going down into silence. (**Psalms 115:17**)

- For the living are conscious that they will die, but as for the dead, they are conscious of nothing at all, neither do they anymore **have** wages, because the remembrance of them has been forgotten. (**Ecclesiastes 9:5**)

- And both of them continued to be naked, the man and his wife, and yet they did not become **ashamed**. (**Genesis 2:25**)

- Also, none of those hoping in you will be **ashamed**. They will be **ashamed** who are dealing treacherously without success. (**Psalms 25:3**)

- May those be **ashamed** and abashed all together who are seeking my soul to sweep it away. May those turn back and be humiliated who are delighting in my calamity. (**Psalms 40:14**)

- O Yehowah, I **have called** upon you. Do make haste to me. Do give ear to my voice when I call to you. (**Psalms 141:1**)
