**Isaiah 25:1**· O Yehowah, you are my God. I exalt you, I laud your name, for you have done wonderful things, counsels from early times, in faithfulness, in trustworthiness.

- Now, look! I am going today in the way of all the earth, and **YOU** well know with all **YOUR** hearts and with all **YOUR** souls that not one word out of all the good words that Yehowah **YOUR God** has spoken to **YOU** has failed. They **have** all come true for **YOU**. Not one word of them has failed. (**Joshua 23:14**)
- In this manner **God**, when he purposed to demonstrate more abundantly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of his counsel, stepped in with an oath. (**Hebrews 6:17**)
- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A **God** of **faithfulness**, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (**Deuteronomy 32:4**)
- And you are righteous as regards all that has come upon us, for faithfully is how you **have** acted, but we are the ones that **have** done wickedly. (**Nehemiah 9:33**)
- And say; Blessed be Yehowah the **God** of my master Abraham, who has not left his loving-kindness and his **trustworthiness** toward my master. I being on the way, Yehowah has led me to the house of the brothers of my master. (**Genesis 24:27**)
- **God** is not a man that he should tell lies, neither a son of mankind that he should feel regret. Has he himself said it and will he not do it, and has he spoken and will he not carry it out? (**Numbers 23:19**)
- For I shall declare the **name** of Yehowah. Do **YOU** attribute greatness to our **God**! (**Deuteronomy 32:3**)

- Who, now, is the man fearful of Yehowah? He will instruct him in the way that he will choose. (**Psalms 25:12**)
- I shall **laud** Yehowah according to his righteousness, and I will make melody to the **name** of Yehowah the Most High. (**Psalms 7:17**)
- Exalt Yehowah our **God** and bow down yourselves at his footstool, he is holy. (**Psalms 99:5**)
- I will **exalt** you, O my **God** the King, and I will bless your **name** to time indefinite, even forever. (**Psalms 145:1**)
- Make melody to Yehowah, O **you** loyal ones of his, give thanks to his holy memorial. (**Psalms 30:4**)
- Every breathing thing, let it praise Yah. Praise Yah, **you** people! (**Psalms 150:6**)
- Many **things** you yourself **have** done, O Yehowah my **God**, even your **wonderful** works and your thoughts toward us, there is none to be compared to you. Were I inclined to tell and speak of them, they **have** become more numerous than I can recount. (**Psalms 40:5**)
- Sing to Yehowah a new song, for **wonderful** are the **things** that he has done. His right hand, even his holy arm, has gained salvation for him. (**Psalms 98:1**)
- O let people give thanks to Yehowah for his loving-kindness and for his **wonderful** works to the sons of men. (**Psalms 107:8**)
- Generation after generation will commend your works, and about your mighty acts they will tell. (**Psalms 145:4**)
- Yehowah himself has broken up the counsel of the nations, he has thwarted the thoughts of the peoples. (**Psalms 33:10**)
- To time indefinite the very counsel of Yehowah will stand, the thoughts of his heart are to one generation after another generation. (**Psalms 33:11**)
- And the heavens will **laud** your marvelous act, O Yehowah, yes, your **faithfulness** in the congregation of the holy ones. (**Psalms 89:5**)
- Consequently David blessed Yehowah before the eyes of all the congregation and David said; Blessed may you be, O Yehowah the **God** of Israel our father, from time indefinite even to time indefinite. (**1 Chronicles 29:10**)

- Without fail I shall exult in Yehowah. My soul will be joyful in my **God**. For he has clothed me with the garments of salvation, with the sleeveless coat of righteousness he has enwrapped me, like the bridegroom who, in a priestly way, puts on a headdress, and like the bride who decks herself with her ornamental **things**. (**Isaiah 61:10**)

- This also is what has come forth from Yehowah of armies himself, who has been **wonderful** in counsel, who has done greatly in effectual working. (**Isaiah 28:29**)
- I **have** besprinkled my bed with myrrh, aloes and cinnamon. (**Proverbs 7:17**)
- Through him let us always offer to **God** a sacrifice of praise, that is, the fruit of lips which make public declaration to his **name**. (**Hebrews 13:15**)
- Who will not really fear you, Yehowah, and glorify your **name**, because you alone are loyal? For all the nations will come and worship before you, because your righteous decrees **have** been made manifest. (**Revelation 15:4**)
- My strength and **my** might is Yah, since he serves for my salvation. This is my **God**, and I shall **laud** him, my father's **God**, and I shall raise him on high. (**Exodus 15:2**)
