Psalms 143:7" O hurry, answer me, O Yehowah. My spirit has come to an end. Do not conceal your face from me, or else I must become comparable with those going down into the pit.

- Do look upon me, answer me, O Yehowah my God. Do make my eyes shine, that I may not fall asleep in death. (Psalms 13:3)
- Be pleased, O Yehowah, to deliver me. O Yehowah, to my assistance do make haste. (Psalms 40:13)
- But I am afflicted and poor. O God, do act quickly for me. You are my help and the Provider of escape for me. O Yehowah, do not be too late. (Psalms 70:5)
- When my spirit fainted away within me. Then you yourself knew my roadway. In the path in which I walk they have hidden a trap for me. (Psalms 142:3)
- Do not conceal your face from me. Do not in anger turn your servant away. My assistance you must become. Do not forsake me and do not leave me, O my God of salvation. (Psalms 27:9)
