Jeremiah 18:20· Should bad be repaid for good? For they have excavated a pit for my soul. Remember my standing before you to speak good even concerning them, to turn back your rage from them.

- And they render to me bad for **good** and hatred for my love. (Psalms 109:5)
- For without cause they **have** hid for me their netted **pit**, without cause they **have** dug it for my **soul**. (Psalms 35:7)
- A net they **have** prepared for my steps, my **soul** has become bowed down. They **excavated before** me a pitfall, they **have** fallen into the midst of it. (Psalms 57:6)
- And he was about to say to annihilate them, if it had not been for Moses his chosen one, who stood in the gap **before** him, to **turn back** his **rage** from bringing them to ruin. (Psalms 106:23)
- And I kept looking for a man from among them who would be repairing the stone wall and **standing** in the gap **before** me in behalf of the land, in order for me not to bring it to ruin, and I found no one. (Ezekiel 22:30)
- So Moses and Aaron were brought **back** to Pharaoh, and he said to them; Go, serve Yehowah **YOUR** God. Who in particular are the ones going? (Exodus 10:8)
- Accordingly Jonathan spoke well of David to Saul his father and said to him; Do not let the king sin against his servant David, for he has not sinned toward you and his works **have** been very **good** toward you. (1 Samuel 19:4)
- A **pit** he has **excavated**, and he proceeded to dig it, but he will fall into the hole that he went making (Psalms 7:15)

- They reward me with bad for **good**, bereavement to my **soul**. (**Psalms 35:12**)
- And they were rewarding me with bad for **good**, they kept resisting me in return for my pursuing what is **good**. (**Psalms 38:20**)
- The presumptuous **have excavated** pitfalls to get me, those who are not in accord with your Law. (**Psalms 119:85**)
- As for anyone repaying bad for **good**, bad will not move away from his house. (**Proverbs 17:13**)
