Jeremiah 25:15 For this is what Yehowah the God of Israel said to me; Take this cup of the wine of rage out of my hand, and you must make all the nations to whom I am sending you drink it.

- His eyes will see his decay, and from the **rage** of the Almighty he will **drink**. **(Job 21:20)**
- For there is a **cup** in the **hand** of **Yehowah**, and the **wine** is foaming, it is full of mixture. And he will surely pour **out** its dregs from it, all the wicked ones of the earth will drain them **out**, **drink** them. **(Psalms 75:8)**
- Rouse yourself, rouse yourself, rise up, O Jerusalem, you who have drunk at the **hand** of **Yehowah** his **cup** of **rage**. The goblet, the **cup** causing reeling, you have drunk, you have drained **out**. **(Isaiah 51:17)**
- And all the kings of the north who are near and far away, one after the other, and all the other kingdoms of the earth that are on the surface of the ground, and the king of Sheshach himself will **drink** after them. **(Jeremiah 25:26)**
- He will also **drink** of the **wine** of the anger of **God** that is poured **out** undiluted into the **cup** of his wrath, and he shall be tormented with fire and sulphur in the sight of the holy angels and in the sight of the Lamb. **(Revelation 14:10)**
- And the great city split into three parts, and the cities of the **nations** fell, and Babylon the Great was remembered in the sight of **God**, to give her the **cup** of the **wine** of the anger of his wrath. **(Revelation 16:19)**
- He will rain down upon the wicked ones traps, fire and sulphur and a scorching wind, as the portion of their **cup**. **(Psalms 11:6)**

- You have caused your people to see hardship. You have made us **drink wine sending** us reeling. (**Psalms 60:3**)
- For **Yehowah** has indignation against all the **nations**, and **rage** against all their army. He **must** devote them to destruction, he **must** give them to the slaughter. (**Isaiah 34:2**)
- And I kept stamping down peoples in my anger, and I proceeded to **make** them drunk with my **rage** and to bring down to the earth their spurting blood. (**Isaiah 63:6**)
- This is what occurred as the word of **Yehowah** to Jeremiah the prophet concerning the **nations**. (**Jeremiah 46:1**)
- Make him drunk, O men, for he has put on great airs against **Yehowah** himself, and Moab has slapped around in his vomit, and he has become an object of ridicule, even he himself. (**Jeremiah 48:26**)
- For this is what **Yehowah** has **said**; Look! Although it is not their custom to **drink** the **cup**, they will **drink** without fail. And you yourself, will you be absolutely left unpunished? You will not be left unpunished, for you will **drink** without fail. (**Jeremiah 49:12**)
- Exult and rejoice, O daughter of Edom, dwelling as you do in the land of Uz. To you also the **cup** will pass along. You will become drunk and show yourself in nakedness. (**Lamentations 4:21**)
- In the way of your sister you have walked, and I shall have to give her **cup** into your hand. (**Ezekiel 23:31**)
- You yourself will also become drunk, you will become something hidden. You yourself also will seek a stronghold from the enemy. (**Nahum 3:11**)
- And one of the four living creatures gave the seven angels seven golden bowls that were full of the anger of **God**, who lives forever and ever. (**Revelation 15:7**)
