~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Christ** - The first things I promised have come, but new things I am telling out now, I will cause you to see events before they happen' (Isaiah 42:9) ^[17] - References

Isaiah 42:9.. The first things, here they have come, but new things I am telling out. Before they begin to spring up, I cause **you** people to hear them.

- Then Yehowah said to him; What is that in your hand? To which he said; A rod. (Exodus 4:2)
- Next he said; Throw it on the earth. So he threw it on the earth, and it became a serpent, and Moses began to flee from it. (Exodus 4:3)
- Yehowah now said to Moses; Thrust your hand **out** and grab hold of it by the tail. So he thrust his hand **out** and grabbed hold of it, and it became a rod in his palm. (Exodus 4:4)
- And I shall make a great nation **out** of you and I shall bless you and I will make your name great, and prove yourself a blessing. (Genesis 12:2)
- But the nation that they will serve I **am** judging, and after that they will go **out** with many goods. (Genesis 15:14)
- As for me, look! My covenant is with you, and you will certainly become a father of a crowd of nations. (Genesis 17:4)
- Not a promise failed **out** of all the good promise that Yehowah had made to the house of Israel, it all came true. (Joshua 21:45)
- Tell the **things** that are to **come** afterward, that we may know that **you** are gods. Yes, **you** ought to do good or do bad, that we may gaze about and see it at the same time. (Isaiah 41:23)
- Look! I **am** doing something **new**. Now it will **spring** up. **you people** will know it, will **you** not? Really, through the wilderness I shall set a way, through the desert rivers. (Isaiah 43:19)

- For the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will not do a thing unless he has revealed his confidential matter to his servants the prophets. (**Amos 3:7**)
- For prophecy was at no time brought by man's will, but men spoke from God as they were borne along by Holy Spirit. (**2 Peter 1:21**)
- Even though I walk in the valley of deep shadow, I fear nothing bad, for you are with me, your rod and your staff are the **things** that comfort me. (**Psalms 23:4**)
- Remember the first **things** of a long time ago, that I **am** the Divine One and there is no other God, nor anyone like me. (**Isaiah 46:9**)
- The One **telling** from the beginning the finale, and from long ago the **things** that **have** not been done, the One saying; My own counsel will stand, and everything that is my delight I shall do. (**Isaiah 46:10**)
- The first **things** I **have** told even from that time, and **out** of my own mouth they went forth, and I kept making them heard. Suddenly I acted, and the **things** proceeded to **come** in. (**Isaiah 48:3**)
- You **have** heard. Behold it all. As for **you people**, will **you** not tell it? I **have** made you **hear new things** from the present time, even **things** kept in reserve, that you **have** not known. (**Isaiah 48:6**)
- Therefore **hear**, O men, the counsel of Yehowah that he has formulated against Babylon and his thoughts that he has thought **out** against the land of the Chaldeans. Surely the little ones of the flock will be dragged about. Surely on account of them he will cause their abiding place to be desolated. (**Jeremiah 50:45**)
- And the seven angels with the seven trumpets prepared to blow them. (**Revelation 8:6**)
- And the One seated on the throne said; Look! I **am** making all **things** new. Also, he says; Write, because these words are faithful and true. (**Revelation 21:5**)
