Psalms 41:9... Also the man at peace with me, in whom I trusted, who was eating my bread, has magnified his heel against me.

- Further, when he offered the sacrifices, Absalom sent for Ahithophel the Gilonite, David's counselor, from his city Giloh. And the conspiracy kept getting stronger, and the people were continually growing in number with Absalom. (**2 Samuel 15:12**)
- All the men of my intimate group detest me, and those whom I loved have turned **against** me. (**Job 19:19**)
- But it was you, a mortal man who was as my equal, one familiar to me and my acquaintance. (**Psalms 55:13**)
- As far as the boundary they have sent you. The very men in covenant with you have all deceived you. The men at **peace** with you have prevailed **against** you. Those **eating** food with you will place a net under you as one in whom there is no discernment. (**Obadiah 1:7**)
- And as they were reclining at the table and **eating**, Jesus said; Truly I say to **you**, one of **you**, who is **eating** with me, will betray me. (**Mark 14:18**)
- I am not talking about all of **you**, I know the ones I have chosen. But it is in order, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, He that used to feed on my **bread** has lifted up his **heel against** me. (**John 13:18**)
- Therefore Jesus answered; It is that one to whom I shall give the morsel that I dip. And so, having dipped the morsel, he took and gave it to Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot. (**John 13:26**)
- And to David the report was made, saying; Ahithophel himself is among those conspiring with Absalom. At this David said; Turn, please, the counsel of Ahithophel into foolishness, O Yehowah! (**2 Samuel 15:31**)

- And I shall come upon him when he is weary and feeble in both hands, and I shall certainly drive him into trembling, and all the people that are with him will have to flee, and I shall certainly strike down the king by himself. (2 Samuel 17:2)
- For it was not an enemy that proceeded to reproach me, otherwise I could put up with it. It was not an intense hater of me that assumed great airs **against** me, otherwise I could conceal myself from him. (Psalms 55:12)
- For I heard the bad report of many. There was fright all around. **TELL** out, that we may tell out about him. Every mortal man bidding me Peace! They are watching for my limping; Perhaps he will be fooled, so that we may prevail **against** him and take our revenge upon him. (Jeremiah 20:10)
- And, look! All the women that have been left remaining in the house of the king of Judah are being brought out to the princes of the king of Babylon, and they are saying; The men at **peace** with you have allured you and prevailed over you. They have caused your foot to sink down into the very ooze, they have retreated in the opposite direction. (Jeremiah 38:22)
- So it came about in the seventh month that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah the son of Elishama of the royal offspring and of the principal men of the king and ten other men with him came to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam at Mizpah. And there they began to eat **bread** together in Mizpah. (Jeremiah 41:1)
- For a son is despising a father, a daughter is rising up **against** her mother, a daughter-in-law **against** her mother-in-law, a man's enemies are the men of his household. (Micah 7:6)
- Simon the Cananaean, and Judas Iscariot, who later betrayed him. (Matthew 10:4)
- In reply he said; He that dips his hand with me in the bowl is the one that will betray me. (Matthew 26:23)
- But Jesus said to him; Fellow, for what purpose are you present? Then they came forward and laid hands on Jesus and took him into custody. (Matthew 26:50)
- Then he took the twelve aside and said to them; Look! We are going up to Jerusalem, and all the things written by means of the prophets as to the Son of man will be completed. (Luke 18:31)

- **When I was with them I used to watch over them on account of your own name which you have given me, and I have kept them, and not one of them is destroyed except the son of destruction, in order, that the scripture might be fulfilled. (John 17:12)**
- **Men, brothers, it was necessary for the scripture to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by David's mouth about Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus. (Acts of Apostles 1:16)**
- **For the inhabitants of Jerusalem and their rulers did not know this One, but, when acting as judges, they fulfilled the things voiced by the Prophets, which things are read aloud every Sabbath. (Acts of Apostles 13:27)**
