Isaiah 44:28 The One saying of Cyrus: He is my shepherd. And all that I delight in he will completely carry out. Even in my saying of Jerusalem: She will be rebuilt. And of the temple: You will have your foundation laid.

- But now do not feel hurt and do not be angry with yourselves because **you** sold me here, because for the preservation of life God has sent me ahead of **you**. **(Genesis 45:5)**
- For this is the second year of the famine in the midst of the earth, and there are yet five years in which there **will** be no plowing time or harvest. **(Genesis 45:6)**
- Consequently God sent me ahead of **you** in order to place a remnant for **you** men in the earth and to keep **you** alive by a great escape. **(Genesis 45:7)**
- And in the first year of **Cyrus** the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word from the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, Yehowah roused the spirit of **Cyrus** the king of Persia so that he caused a cry to pass through all his realm, and also in writing, **saying; (Ezra 1:1)**
- This is what **Cyrus** the king of Persia has said; All the kingdoms of the earth Yehowah the God of the heavens has given me, and he himself has commissioned me to build him a house in **Jerusalem**, which is in Judah. **(Ezra 1:2)**
- I **have** roused up someone from the north, and he **will** come. From the rising of the sun he **will** call upon my name. And he **will** come upon deputy rulers as if they were clay and just as a potter that tramples down the moist material. **(Isaiah 41:25)**
- This is what Yehowah has said to his anointed one, to **Cyrus**, whose right hand I **have** taken hold of, to subdue before him nations,

so that I may ungird **even** the hips of kings, to open before him the two-leaved doors, so that **even** the gates **will** not be shut. (**Isaiah 45:1**)

- The One calling from the sunrising a bird of prey, from a distant land the man to execute my counsel. I **have even** spoken it, I shall also bring it in. I **have** formed it, I shall also do it. (**Isaiah 46:11**)

- I myself **have** roused up someone in righteousness, and all his ways I shall straighten out. He is the one that **will** build my city, and those of mine in exile he **will** let go, not for a price nor for bribery, Yehowah of armies has said. (**Isaiah 45:13**)

- Be collected together, all **you** people, and hear. Who among them has told these things? Yehowah himself has loved him. He **will** do what is his **delight** upon Babylon, and his own arm **will** be upon the Chaldeans. (**Isaiah 48:14**)

- And in the first year of **Cyrus** the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, Yehowah roused the spirit of **Cyrus** the king of Persia, so that he caused a cry to pass through all his kingdom, and also in writing, **saying; (2 Chronicles 36:22)**

- This is what **Cyrus** the king of Persia has said; All the kingdoms of the earth Yehowah the God of the heavens has given me, and he himself has commissioned me to build him a house in **Jerusalem**, which is in Judah. Whoever there is among **you** of all his people, Yehowah his God be with him. So let him go up. (**2 Chronicles 36:23**)

- In the first year of **Cyrus** the king, **Cyrus** the king put an order through concerning the house of God in **Jerusalem**; Let the house be rebuilt as the place where they are to offer sacrifices, and its **foundations** are to be fixed, its height being sixty cubits, its width sixty cubits. (**Ezra 6:3**)

- And in the first year of **Cyrus** the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, Yehowah roused the spirit of **Cyrus** the king of Persia, so that he caused a cry to pass through all his kingdom, and also in writing, **saying; (2 Chronicles 36:22)**

- This is what **Cyrus** the king of Persia has said; All the kingdoms of the earth Yehowah the God of the heavens has given me, and he himself has commissioned me to build him a house in **Jerusalem**, which is in Judah. Whoever there is among **you** of all his people, Yehowah his God be with him. So let him go up. (**2 Chronicles 36:23**)

- This is what **Cyrus** the king of Persia has said; All the kingdoms of the earth Yehowah the God of the heavens has given me, and he himself has commissioned me to build him a house in **Jerusalem**, which is in Judah. (**Ezra 1:2**)
- However, Zerubbabel and Jeshua and the rest of the heads of the paternal houses of Israel said to them; **You have** nothing to do with us in building a house to our God, for we ourselves shall together build to Yehowah the God of Israel, just as King **Cyrus** the king of Persia has commanded us. (**Ezra 4:3**)
- And the older men of the Jews were building and making progress under the prophesying of Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the grandson of Iddo, and they built and finished it due to the order of the God of Israel and due to the order of **Cyrus** and Darius and Artaxerxes the king of Persia. (**Ezra 6:14**)
- A king's heart is as streams of water in the hand of Yehowah. Everywhere that he **delights** to, he turns it. (**Proverbs 21:1**)
- A time to kill and a time to heal, a time to break down and a time to build. (**Ecclesiastes 3:3**)
- And in that day you **will** be sure to say; I shall thank you, O Yehowah, for although you got incensed at me, your anger gradually turned back, and you proceeded to comfort me. (**Isaiah 12:1**)
- When the very people in Zion **will** dwell in **Jerusalem**, you **will** by no means weep. He **will** without fail show you favor at the sound of your outcry, as soon as he hears it he **will** actually answer you. (**Isaiah 30:19**)
- And I **will** give you the treasures in the darkness and the hidden treasures in the concealment places, in order, that you may know that I am Yehowah, the One calling you by your name, the God of Israel. (**Isaiah 45:3**)
- Like a man whom his own mother keeps comforting, so I myself shall keep comforting **you** people, and in the case of **Jerusalem** **you will** be comforted. (**Isaiah 66:13**)
- And I **will** set among them a sign, and I **will** send some of those who are escaped to the nations, to Tarshish, Pul, and Lud, those drawing the bow, Tubal and Javan, the faraway islands, who **have** not heard a report about me or seen my glory, and they **will** for certain tell about my glory among the nations. (**Isaiah 66:19**)

- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and the city **will** certainly be built to Yehowah from the Tower of Hananel to the Corner Gate. (**Jeremiah 31:38**)
- Against the land of Merathaim, come up against her and against the inhabitants of Pekod. Let there be a massacre and a devoting to destruction close upon them, is the utterance of Yehowah, and do according to all that I **have** commanded you. (**Jeremiah 50:21**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; In the day of my cleansing **YOU** from all **YOUR** errors I **will** also cause the cities to be inhabited, and the devastated places must be rebuilt. (**Ezekiel 36:33**)
- And as for this Daniel, he prospered in the kingdom of Darius and in the kingdom of **Cyrus** the Persian. (**Daniel 6:28**)
- When I raised my eyes, then I saw, and, look! A ram standing before the watercourse, and it had two horns. And the two horns were tall, but the one was taller than the other, and the taller was the one that came up afterward. (**Daniel 8:3**)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; I shall certainly return to **Jerusalem** with mercies. My own house **will** be built in her, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and a measuring line itself **will** be stretched out over **Jerusalem**. (**Zechariah 1:16**)
- And you, O Bethlehem of the land of Judah, are by no means the most insignificant city among the governors of Judah, for out of you **will** come forth a governing one, who **will shepherd** my people, Israel. (**Matthew 2:6**)
- And after removing him, he raised up for them David as king, respecting whom he bore witness and said; I **have** found David the son of Jesse, a man agreeable to my heart, who **will** do all the things I desire. (**Acts of Apostles 13:22**)
