- And Jesus approached and spoke to them, **saying**; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (**Matthew 28:18**)
- And he shall shepherd the people with an iron rod so that they **will** be broken to pieces like clay vessels, the same as I have received from my Father. (**Revelation 2:27**)
- And she gave birth to a son, a male, who is to shepherd all the nations with an iron rod. And her child was caught away to God and to his throne. (**Revelation 12:5**)
- And **out** of his mouth there protrudes a sharp long sword, that he may strike the nations with it, and he **will** shepherd them with a rod of iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of God the Almighty. (**Revelation 19:15**)
- And the seventh angel blew his trumpet. And loud voices occurred in heaven, **saying**; The kingdom of the world did become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he **will** rule as king forever and ever. (**Revelation 11:15**)
- And I saw, and, look! The Lamb standing upon the Mount **Zion**, and with him a hundred and forty-four thousand having his name and the name of his Father written on their foreheads. (**Revelation 14:1**)
- You **will** break them with an iron scepter, as though a potter's vessel you **will** dash them to pieces. (**Psalms 2:9**)
- And in your splendor go on to success. Ride in the cause of truth and humility and righteousness, and your right hand **will** instruct you in fear-inspiring things. (**Psalms 45:4**)

- And then the sign of the Son of man **will** appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth **will** beat themselves in lamentation, and they **will** see the Son of man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. (**Matthew 24:30**)
- So he said to him; Well done, good slave! Because in a very small matter you have proved yourself faithful, hold authority over ten cities. (**Luke 19:17**)
- Look! He is coming with the clouds, and every eye **will** see him, and those who pierced him, and all the tribes of the earth **will** beat themselves in grief because of him. Yes, Amen. (**Revelation 1:7**)
- And I saw, and, look! A white horse, and the one seated upon it had a bow, and a crown was given him, and he went forth conquering and to complete his conquest. (**Revelation 6:2**)
- But the nations became wrathful, and your own wrath came, and the appointed time for the dead to be judged, and to give their reward to your slaves the prophets and to the holy ones and to those fearing your name, the small and the great, and to bring to ruin those ruining the earth. (**Revelation 11:18**)
- I shall see him, but not now, I shall behold him, but not near. A star **will** certainly step forth **out** of Jacob, and a scepter **will** indeed rise **out** of Israel. And he **will** certainly break apart the temples of Moab's head and the cranium of all the sons of tumult of war. (**Numbers 24:17**)
- Ask of me, that I may give nations as your inheritance and the ends of the earth as your own possession. (**Psalms 2:8**)
- Sing to **Yehowah** a new song, for wonderful are the things that he has done. His right hand, even his holy arm, has gained salvation for him. (**Psalms 98:1**)
- And many peoples **will** certainly go and say; Come, **you** people, and let us go up to the mountain of **Yehowah**, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he **will** instruct us about his ways, and we **will** walk in his paths. For **out** of **Zion** Law **will** go forth, and the word of **Yehowah** **out** of Jerusalem. (**Isaiah 2:3**)
- And with righteousness he must judge the lowly ones, and with uprightness he must give reproof in behalf of the meek ones of the earth. And he must strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the spirit of his lips he **will** put the wicked one to death. (**Isaiah 11:4**)

- Look! As a witness to the national groups I have given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups. (**Isaiah 55:4**)
- And as for your people, all of them **will** be righteous, to time indefinite they **will** hold possession of the land, the sprout of my planting, the work of my hands, for me to be beautified. (**Isaiah 60:21**)
- And I **will** make **you** pass under the rod and bring **you** into the bond of the covenant. (**Ezekiel 20:37**)
- When they took hold of you by the hand, you got to be crushed, and you caused a split in their entire shoulder. And when they supported themselves upon you, you got to be broken, and you caused all their hips to wobble. (**Ezekiel 29:7**)
- And as for you, O son of man, take for yourself a stick and write upon it, For Judah and for the sons of Israel his partners. And take another stick and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and all the house of Israel his partners. (**Ezekiel 37:16**)
- And to him there were given rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages should all serve even him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership that **will** not pass away, and his kingdom one that **will** not be brought to ruin. (**Daniel 7:14**)
- Next, the end, when he hands over the kingdom to his God and Father, when he has brought to nothing all government and all authority and power. (**1 Corinthians 15:24**)
- Still, you do have this, that you hate the deeds of the sect of Nicolaus, which I also hate. (**Revelation 2:6**)
- Your people will offer themselves willingly on the day of your military force. In the splendors of holiness, from the womb of the dawn, you have your company of young men just like dewdrops (**Psalms 110:3**)
- And a reed like a rod was given me as he said; Get up and measure the temple sanctuary of God and the altar and those worshipping in it. (**Revelation 11:1**)
