Psalms 116:3" The ropes of death encircled me and the distressing circumstances of Sheol themselves found me. Distress and grief I kept finding.

- The ropes of death encircled me, flash floods of good-for-nothing men also kept terrifying me. (Psalms 18:4)
- I myself said; In the midst of my days I will go into the gates of Sheol. I must be deprived of the remainder of my years. (Isaiah 38:10)
- I have become disconcerted, I have bowed low to an extreme degree, all day long I have walked about sad. (Psalms 38:6)
- He was despised and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains and for having acquaintance with sickness. And there was as if the concealing of one's face from us. He was despised, and we held him as of no account. (Isaiah 53:3)
- But David swore in addition and said; Your father must surely know that I have found favor in your eyes, and so would say, Do not let Jonathan know this for fear he may feel hurt. But, in fact, as Yehowah is living and as your soul is living, there is just about a step between me and death! (1 Samuel 20:3)
- And it became very distressing to David, because the people said to stone him, for the soul of all the people had become bitter, each one because of his sons and his daughters. So David took to strengthening himself by Yehowah his God. (1 Samuel 30:6)
- The ropes of Sheol themselves surrounded me, the snares of death confronted me. (2 Samuel 22:6)
