Isaiah 50:9... Look! The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself will help me. Who is there that can pronounce me wicked? Look! All of them, like a garment, will wear out. A mere moth will eat them up.

- For it is contained in Scripture; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one exercising faith in it will by any means come to disappointment. (1 Peter 2:6)
- It is to you, therefore, that he is precious, because you are believers, but to those not believing, the identical stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (1 Peter 2:7)
- And a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense. These are stumbling because they are disobedient to the word. To this very end they were also appointed. (1 Peter 2:8)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am laying as a foundation in Zion a stone, a tried stone, the precious corner of a sure foundation. No one exercising faith will get panicky. (Isaiah 28:16)
- I have become one estranged to my brothers, and a foreigner to the sons of my mother. (Psalms 69:8)
- He was despised and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains and for having acquaintance with sickness. And there was as if the concealing of one's face from us. He was despised, and we held him as of no account. (Isaiah 53:3)
- But he looked upon them and said; What, then, does this that is written mean, The stone which the builders rejected, this has become the chief cornerstone? (Luke 20:17)

- The stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (Psalms 118:22)
- This has come to be from Yehowah himself, it is wonderful in our eyes. (Psalms 118:23)
- Jesus said to them; Did you never read in the Scriptures: The stone that the builders rejected is the one that has become the chief cornerstone. From Yehowah this has come to be, and it is marvelous in our eyes? (Matthew 21:42)
- And he must become as a sacred place, but as a stone to strike against and as a rock over which to stumble to both the houses of Israel, as a trap and as a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 8:14)
- Against you, you alone, I have sinned, and what is bad in your eyes I have done, in order, that you may prove to be righteous when you speak, that you may be in the clear when you judge. (Psalms 51:4)
- They themselves will perish, but you yourself will keep standing, and just like a garment they will all of them wear out. Just like clothing you will replace them, and they will finish their turn. (Psalms 102:26)
- Never may that happen! But let God be found true, though every man be found a liar, even as it is written: That you might be proved righteous in your words and might win when you are being judged. (Romans 3:4)
- However, if our unrighteousness brings God's righteousness to the fore, what shall we say? God is not unjust when he vents his wrath, is he? I am speaking as a man does. (Romans 3:5)
- Never may that happen! How, otherwise, will God judge the world? (Romans 3:6)
- And he is like something rotten that wears out, like a garment that a moth actually eats up. (Job 13:28)
- By reproofs against error you have corrected man, and you consume his desirable things just as a moth does. Surely every earthling man is an exhalation. (Psalms 39:11)
- And here, now, there is coming a war chariot of men, with a span of steeds! And he began to speak up and say; She has fallen! Babylon has fallen, and all the graven images of her gods he has broken to the earth! (Isaiah 21:9)

- For the moth will eat them up just as if a garment, and the clothes moth will eat them up just as if wool. But as for my righteousness, it will prove to be even to time indefinite, and my salvation to unnumbered generations. (Isaiah 51:8)
- And I was like the moth to Ephraim and just like rottenness to the house of Judah. (Hosea 5:12)
