Psalms 118:22.. The stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner.

- I do love, because Yehowah hears my voice, my entreaties. (Psalms 116:1)
- Look! God is my salvation. I shall trust and be in no dread, for Yah, Yehowah is my strength and my might, and he came to be the salvation of me. (Isaiah 12:2)
- He was despised and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains and for having acquaintance with sickness. And there was as if the concealing of one's face from us. He was despised, and we held him as of no account. (Isaiah 53:3)
- Did **you** never read this scripture: The stone that the **builders rejected**, this **has become** the chief cornerstone. (Mark 12:10)
- But he looked upon them and said; What, then, does this that is written mean: The stone which the **builders rejected**, this **has become** the chief cornerstone? (Luke 20:17)
- Coming to him as to a living stone, **rejected**, it is true, by men, but chosen, precious, with God. (1 Peter 2:4)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has** said; Here I am laying as a foundation in Zion a stone, a tried stone, the precious **corner** of a sure foundation. No one exercising faith will get panicky. (Isaiah 28:16)
- Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you will **become** a level land. And he will certainly bring forth the headstone. There will be shoutings to it; How charming! How charming! (Zechariah 4:7)

- But he looked upon them and said; What, then, does this that is written mean, The stone which the **builders rejected**, this **has become** the chief cornerstone? (**Luke 20:17**)
- This is the stone that was treated by **you builders** as of no account that **has become** the **head** of the corner. (**Acts of Apostles 4:11**)
- For no man can lay any other foundation than what is laid, which is Jesus Christ. (**1 Corinthians 3:11**)
- And **you** have been built up upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, while Christ Jesus himself is the foundation cornerstone. (**Ephesians 2:20**)
- For it is contained in Scripture; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one exercising faith in it will by any means come to disappointment. (**1 Peter 2:6**)
- For I myself, Yehowah, shall speak what word I shall speak, and it will be done. There will be no postponement anymore, for in **YOUR** days, O rebellious house, I shall speak a word and certainly do it, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 12:25**)
- Son of man, make known to Jerusalem her detestable things. (**Ezekiel 16:2**)
- In order for the heart to melt and in order to multiply those who are overthrown at all their gates, I will make a slaughter by the sword. Alas, it is made for a glittering, polished for a slaughter! (**Ezekiel 21:15**)
- For, look! The stone that I have put before Joshua! Upon the one stone there are seven eyes. Here I am engraving its engraving, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and I will take away the error of that land in one day. (**Zechariah 3:9**)
- Jesus said to them; Did **you** never read in the Scriptures: The stone that the **builders rejected** is the one that **has become** the chief cornerstone. From Yehowah this **has** come to be, and it is marvelous in our eyes? (**Matthew 21:42**)
- He now said to them; These are my words which I spoke to **you** while I was yet with **you**, that all the things written in the Law of Moses and in the Prophets and Psalms about me must be fulfilled. (**Luke 24:44**)

- But in this way God **has** fulfilled the things he announced beforehand through the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer. (**Acts of Apostles 3:18**)
- Explaining and proving by references that it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead, and saying; This is the Christ, this Jesus whom I am publishing to **you**. (**Acts of Apostles 17:3**)
- As it is written; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense, but he that rests his faith on it will not come to disappointment. (**Romans 9:33**)
- It is to **you**, therefore, that he is precious, because **you** are believers, but to those not believing, the identical stone that the **builders rejected has become the head** of the corner. (**1 Peter 2:7**)
