

CHRIST - THERE IN ZION I SHALL CAUSE THE HORN OF DAVID TO GROW

~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Christ** - There in Zion I shall cause the horn of David to grow, I have placed a lamp there for my anointed one (Psalms 132:17) ^{[12] - References}

Psalms 132:17 There I shall cause the horn of David to grow. I have set in order a lamp for my anointed one.

- And he will exalt the horn of his people, the praise of all his loyal ones, of the sons of Israel, the people near to him. Praise Yah, **you** people! (Psalms 148:14)
- In that day I shall cause a horn to sprout for the house of Israel, and to you I shall give occasion to open the mouth in the midst of them, and they will **have** to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 29:21)
- And he has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of **David** his servant. (Luke 1:69)
- Eventually Yehowah said to Samuel; For how long will you be mourning for Saul, while I, on the other hand, **have** rejected him from ruling as king over Israel? Fill your horn with oil and go. I shall send you to Jesse the Bethlehemite, because I **have** provided among his sons a king for myself. (1 Samuel 16:1)
- And to his son I shall give one tribe, in order, that **David** my servant may continue having a **lamp** always before me in Jerusalem, the city that I **have** chosen for myself to put my name there. (1 Kings 11:36)
- For, on account of **David**, Yehowah his God gave him a **lamp** in Jerusalem by raising his son up after him and keeping Jerusalem in existence. (1 Kings 15:4)
- And Yehowah did not want to bring the house of **David** to ruin, for the sake of the covenant that he had concluded with **David**, and just as he had said he would give him and his sons a **lamp** always. (2 Chronicles 21:7)

- And now act, for Yehowah himself said to **David**; By the hand of **David** my servant I shall save my people Israel from the hand of the Philistines and from the hand of all their enemies. (**2 Samuel 3:18**)
- But I shall not take the entire kingdom out of his hand, because a chieftain I shall **set** him for all the days of his life, for the sake of **David** my servant whom I chose, because he kept my commandments and my statutes. (**1 Kings 11:34**)
- And Yehowah did not want to bring Judah to ruin for the sake of **David** his servant, just as he had promised him to give a **lamp** to him and to his sons always. (**2 Kings 8:19**)
- For you yourself will light my **lamp**, O Yehowah, my God himself will make my darkness shine. (**Psalms 18:28**)
- For you are the beauty of their strength, and by your goodwill our horn is exalted. (**Psalms 89:17**)
