- And he proceeded to put his **soul** in his palm and strike the Philistine down, so that Yehowah performed a great salvation for all Israel. You saw it, and you gave way to rejoicing. So why should you sin against innocent blood in having David put to death for nothing? (**1 Samuel 19:5**)
- And they were rewarding me with **bad** for **good**, they kept resisting me in return for my pursuing what is **good**. (**Psalms 38:20**)
- And they render to me **bad** for **good** and hatred for my love. (**Psalms 109:5**)
- Should **bad** be repaid for **good**? For they have excavated a pit for my **soul**. Remember my standing before you to speak **good** even concerning them, to turn back your rage from them. (**Jeremiah 18:20**)
- Jesus replied to them; I displayed to **you** many fine works from the Father. For which of those works are **you** stoning me? (**John 10:32**)
- Jesus answered him; If I spoke wrongly, bear witness concerning the wrong, but if rightly, why do you hit me? (**John 18:23**)
- At that Saul went hurling the spear at him to strike him, and Jonathan came to know that it had been determined upon by his father to put David to death. (**1 Samuel 20:33**)
- Accordingly Jonathan spoke well of David to Saul his father and said to him; Do not let the king sin against his servant David, for he has not sinned toward you and his works have been very **good** toward you. (**1 Samuel 19:4**)
- As for David, he had said; It was altogether for disappointment that I guarded everything that belongs to this fellow in the wilderness

and not a single thing of all that belongs to him showed up missing, and yet he repays me evil in return for **good**. (**1 Samuel 25:21**)

- So Hanun took the servants of David and shaved them and cut their garments in half to their buttocks and sent them away. (**1 Chronicles 19:4**)

- Yes, here they are rewarding us by coming in to drive us out from your possession that you caused us to possess. (**2 Chronicles 20:11**)

- Those hating me without a cause have become even more than the hairs of my head. Those bringing me to silence, being my enemies for no reason, have become numerous. What I had not taken by robbery I then proceeded to give back. (**Psalms 69:4**)
