And there will be enjoyment by him in the fear of Yehowah. And he will not judge by any mere appearance to his eyes, nor reprove simply according to the thing heard by his ears.

[40] - References

- When he saw the crowds he went up into the mountain, and after he sat down his disciples came to him. (Matthew 5:1)
- And he opened his mouth and began teaching them, saying; (Matthew 5:2)
- Happy are those conscious of their spiritual need, since the kingdom of the heavens belongs to them. (Matthew 5:3)
- Happy are those who mourn, since they will be comforted. (Matthew 5:4)
- Happy are the mild-tempered ones, since they will inherit the earth. (Matthew 5:5)
- Happy are those hungering and thirsting for righteousness, since they will be filled. (Matthew 5:6)
- Happy are the merciful, since they will be shown mercy. (Matthew 5:7)
- Happy are the pure in heart, since they will see God. (Matthew5:8)
- Happy are the peaceable, since they will be called sons of God. (Matthew 5:9)
- Happy are those who have been persecuted for righteousness' sake, since the kingdom of the heavens belongs to them. (Matthew 5:10)

- Happy are you when people reproach you and persecute you and lyingly say every sort of wicked thing against you for my sake. (Matthew 5:11)
- And all Israel got to hear of the judicial decision that the king had handed down, and they became fearful because of the king, for they saw that the wisdom of God was within him to execute judicial decision. (1 Kings 3:28)
- Stop judging from the outward appearance, but judge with righteous judgment. (John 7:24)
- And yet if I do judge, my judgment is truthful, because I am not alone, but the Father who sent me is with me. (John 8:16)
- Do not think I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I came, not to destroy, but to fulfill. (Matthew 5:17)
- For truly I say to you that sooner would heaven and earth pass away than for one smallest letter or one particle of a letter to pass away from the Law by any means and not all things take place. (Matthew 5:18)
- Whoever, therefore, breaks one of these least commandments and teaches mankind to that effect, he will be called least in relation to the kingdom of the heavens. As for anyone who does them and teaches them, this one will be called great in relation to the kingdom of the heavens. (Matthew 5:19)
- For I say to you that if YOUR righteousness does not abound more than that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter into the kingdom of the heavens. (Matthew 5:20)
- You heard that it was said to those of ancient times, You must not murder, but whoever commits a murder will be accountable to the court of justice. (Matthew 5:21)
- However, I say to you that everyone who continues wrathful with his brother will be accountable to the court of justice, but whoever addresses his brother with an unspeakable word of contempt will be accountable to the Supreme Court, whereas whoever says; You despicable fool! Will be liable to the fiery Gehenna. (Matthew 5:22)
- If, then, you are bringing your gift to the altar and you there remember that your brother has something against you. (Matthew 5:23)

- Leave your gift there in front of the altar, and go away, first make your peace with your brother, and then, when you have come back, offer up your gift. (Matthew 5:24)
- Be about settling matters quickly with the one complaining against you at Law, while you are with him on the way there, that somehow the complainant may not turn you over to the judge, and the judge to the court attendant, and you get thrown into prison. (Matthew 5:25)
- I say to you for a fact; You will certainly not come out from there until you have paid over the last coin of very little value. (Matthew 5:26)
- You heard that it was said; You must not commit adultery. (Matthew 5:27)
- But I say to you that everyone that keeps on looking at a woman so as to have a passion for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart. (Matthew 5:28)
- If, now, that right eye of yours is making you stumble, tear it out and throw it away from you. For it is more beneficial to you for one of your members to be lost to you than for your whole body to be pitched into Gehenna. (Matthew 5:29)
- Also, if your right hand is making you stumble, cut it off and throw it away from you. For it is more beneficial to you for one of your members to be lost than for your whole body to land in Gehenna. (Matthew 5:30)
- Moreover it was said; Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce. (Matthew 5:31)
- However, I say to YOU that everyone divorcing his wife, except on account of fornication, makes her a subject for adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery. (Matthew 5:32)
- Take good care not to practice YOUR righteousness in front of men in order to be observed by them, otherwise YOU will have no reward with YOUR Father who is in the heavens. (Matthew 6:1)
- Hence when you go making gifts of mercy, do not blow a trumpet ahead of you, just as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may be glorified by men. Truly I say to you; They are having their reward in full. (Matthew 6:2)

- But you, when making gifts of mercy, do not let your left hand know what your right is doing. (Matthew 6:3)
- That your gifts of mercy may be in secret, then your Father who is looking on in secret will repay you. (Matthew 6:4)
- Stop judging from the outward appearance, but judge with righteous judgment. (John 7:24)
- And yet if I do judge, my judgment is truthful, because I am not alone, but the Father who sent me is with me. (John 8:16)
- In that case you will understand the fear of Yehowah, and you will find the very knowledge of God. (Proverbs 2:5)
- The fear of Yehowah means the hating of bad. Self-exaltation and pride and the bad way and the perverse mouth I have hated. (Proverbs 8:13)
- In the days of his flesh Christ offered up supplications and also petitions to the One who was able to save him out of death, with strong outcries and tears, and he was favorably heard for his godly fear. (Hebrews 5:7)
