- O may those who for no **reason** are my **enemies** not rejoice over me, as for those hating me **without** cause, let them not wink the eye. (**Psalms 35:19**)
- The third time he said to them; Why, what bad thing did this man do? I found nothing deserving of death in him, I will therefore chastise and release him. (**Luke 23:22**)
- But it is that the word written in their Law may be fulfilled, They hated me **without** cause. (**John 15:25**)
- They reward me with bad for good, bereavement to my soul. (**Psalms 35:12**)
