Psalms 116:17... To you I shall offer the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and on the name of Yehowah I shall call.

- If he would present it in expression of thanksgiving, then he must present along with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unfermented ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil and unfermented wafers smeared with oil and well-mixed fine flour as ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil. (Leviticus 7:12)
- The one offering thanksgiving as his sacrifice is the one that glorifies me, and as for the one keeping a set way, I will cause him to see salvation by God. (Psalms 50:23)
- And let them offer the sacrifices of thanksgiving and declare his works with a joyful cry. (Psalms 107:22)
- Through him let us always offer to God a sacrifice of praise, that is, the fruit of lips which make public declaration to his name. (Hebrews 13:15)
- For everyone who calls on the name of Yehowah will be saved. (Romans 10:13)
- And in case you should sacrifice a thanksgiving sacrifice to Yehowah, you should sacrifice it to gain approval for you. (Leviticus 22:29)
- In willingness I will sacrifice to you. I shall laud your name, O Yehowah, for it is good. (Psalms 54:6)
- We give thanks to you, O God, we give thanks to you, and your name is near. Men have to declare your wondrous works. (Psalms 75:1)
- Come into his gates with thanksgiving, into his courtyards with praise. Give thanks to him, bless his name. (Psalms 100:4)

And people will actually come from the cities of Judah and from round about Jerusalem and from the land of Benjamin and from the lowland and from the mountainous region and from the Negeb, bringing whole burnt offering and sacrifice and grain offering and frankincense and bringing thanksgiving sacrifice into the house of Yehowah.
