Psalms 27:2" When the evildoers approached against me to eat up my flesh, they being my adversaries and my enemies personally, they themselves stumbled and fell.

- Have none of the practicers of what is hurtful got knowledge, eating up my people as they have eaten bread? They have not called even upon Yehowah. (Psalms 14:4)
- For dogs have surrounded me, the assembly of evildoers themselves have enclosed me. Like a lion they are at my hands and my feet. (Psalms 22:16)
- And as for my enemies, you will certainly give me the back of their neck, and as for those hating me intensely, I shall silence them. (Psalms 18:40)
- I shall break them in pieces so that they will not be able to rise up, they will fall under my feet. (Psalms 18:38)
- But the king said to the Cushite; Is it well with the young man Absalom? To this the Cushite said; May the enemies of my lord the king and all those who rose up against you for evil become as the young man. (2 Samuel 18:32)
- Then Esther said; The man, the adversary and enemy, is this bad Haman. As for Haman, he became terrified because of the king and the queen. (Esther 7:6)
