- Why have the nations been in tumult and the national groups themselves kept muttering an empty thing? (Psalms 2:1)
- The kings of earth take their stand and high officials themselves have massed together as one against Yehowah and against his anointed one. (Psalms 2:2)
- Saying; Let us tear their bands apart and cast their cords away from us! (Psalms 2:3)
- The very One sitting in the heavens will laugh, Yehowah himself will hold them in derision. (Psalms 2:4)
- At that time he will speak to them in his anger and in his hot displeasure he will disturb them. (Psalms 2:5)
- Saying; I, even I, have installed my king upon Zion, my holy mountain. (Psalms 2:6)
- Let me refer to the decree of Yehowah, he has said to me You are my son, I, today, I have become your father. (Psalms 2:7)
- Ask of me, that I may give nations as your inheritance and the ends of the earth as your own possession. (Psalms 2:8)
- You will break them with an iron scepter, as though a potter's vessel you will dash them to pieces. (Psalms 2:9)

- And now, O kings, exercise insight, let yourselves be corrected, O judges of the earth. (Psalms 2:10)
- Serve Yehowah with fear and be joyful with trembling. (Psalms 2:11)
- Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed and You may not perish from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (Psalms 2:12)
- And nations will certainly go to your light, and kings to the brightness of your shining forth. (Isaiah 60:3)
- And those of the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations will look at their corpses for three and a half days, and they do not let their corpses be laid in a tomb. (Revelation 11:9)
- And those dwelling on the earth rejoice over them and enjoy themselves, and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those dwelling on the earth. (Revelation 11:10)
- And after the three and a half days spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet, and great fear fell upon those beholding them. (Revelation 11:11)
- And they heard a loud voice out of heaven say to them; Come on up here. And they went up into heaven in the cloud, and their enemies beheld them. (Revelation 11:12)
- And in that hour a great earthquake occurred, and a tenth of the city fell, and seven thousand persons were killed by the earthquake, and the rest became frightened and gave glory to the God of heaven. (Revelation 11:13)
- The second woe is past. Look! The third woe is coming quickly. (Revelation 11:14)
- And the seventh angel blew his trumpet. And loud voices occurred in heaven, saying; The kingdom of the world did become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he will rule as king forever and ever. (Revelation 11:15)
- And the twenty-four elders who were seated before God upon their thrones fell upon their faces and worshiped God. (Revelation 11:16)
- At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the chaff from the

summer threshing floor, and the wind carried them away so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole earth. (Daniel 2:35)

- And in the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be brought to ruin. And the kingdom itself will not be passed on to any other people. It will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it itself will stand to times indefinite. (Daniel 2:44)
- And he proceeded to make my mouth like a sharp sword. In the shadow of his hand he has hidden me. And he gradually made me a polished arrow. He concealed me in his own quiver. (Isaiah 49:2)
- And he proceeded to say; It has been more than a trivial matter for you to become my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to bring back even the safeguarded ones of Israel, I also have given you for a light of the nations, that my salvation may come to be to the extremity of the earth. (Isaiah 49:6)
- This is what Yehowah, the Repurchaser of Israel, his Holy One, has said to him that is despised in soul, to him that is detested by the nation, to the servant of rulers; Kings themselves will see and certainly rise up, and princes, and they will bow down, by reason of Yehowah, who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel, who chooses you. - The One calling from the sunrising a bird of prey, from a distant land the man to execute my counsel. I have even spoken it, I shall also bring it in. I have formed it, I shall also do it. (Isaiah 46:11)
- I, I myself have spoken. Moreover, I have called him. I have brought him in, and there will be a making of his way successful. (Isaiah 48:15)
